Finished Wall Hanging

Fabric Requirements for Wall Hanging

Red (includes sashing & binding)	3/4 yard
Black	3/8 yard
Yellow	1/8 yard
Button Mad Buttons (www.ButtonMad.com)	SIX (6) sets of FIVE (5) buttons each of farm animals in black and white
Backing	Approximately a 35" x 25" piece of fabric

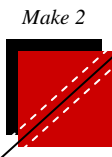


**"Hole in the Barn Door" -
Make SIX (6)
Blocks**

Fabric Cutting Requirements for Block - these instructions are for ONE (1) block. You need SIX (6) of these blocks for the wall hanging.

Red	Cut TWO (2) 3 1/2" squares - then draw a line on the wrong side of the fabric diagonally, corner-to-corner
Red	Cut FOUR (4) 3 1/8" x 1 7/8" strips
Black	Cut TWO (2) 3 1/2" squares
Black	Cut FOUR (4) 3 1/8" x 1 7/8" strips
Yellow	Cut ONE (1) 3 1/8" square

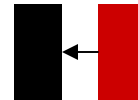

Make 2

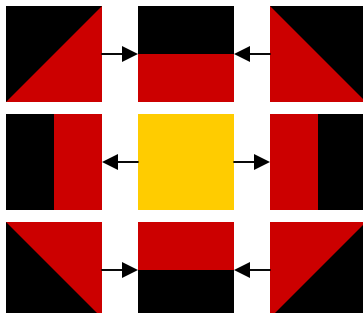
Place the RED squares on the BLACK square and sew 1/4" on EACH side of the line you drew. Then, cut the half-square triangles apart ON the line you drew. You will end up with TWO (2) half-square triangles for each pair of squares you sew together. Press toward the darkest fabric. You need TWO (2) of these for each block, ending up with FOUR (4) half-square triangles.

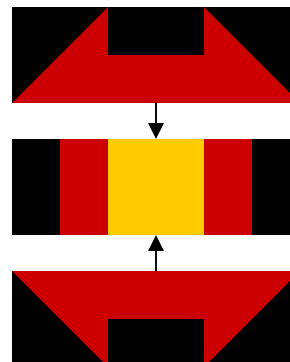

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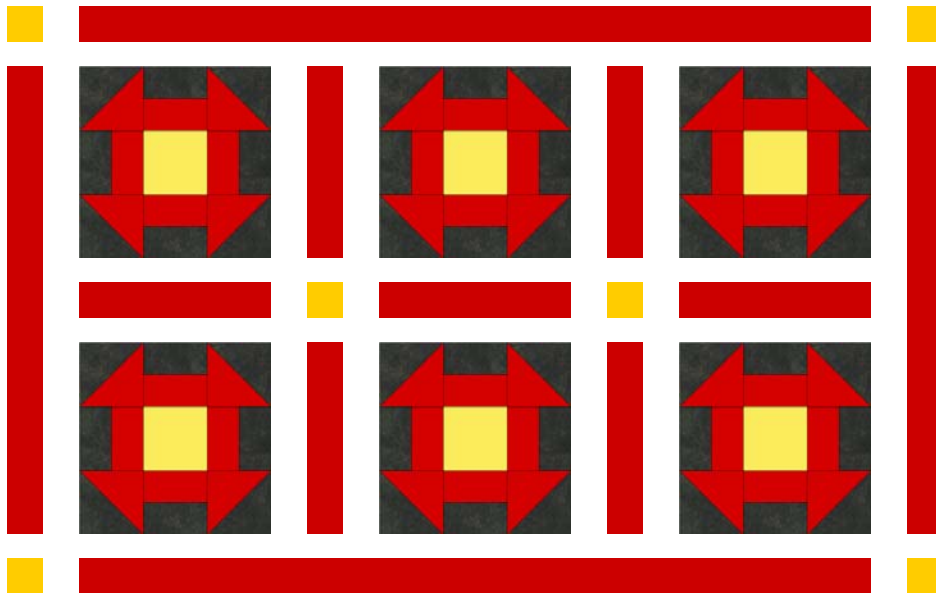


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Unfinished Block for Baby Quilt = 8 1/2"

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Fabric & Cutting Requirements to Finish the Wall Hanging	
Red	Cut SEVEN (7) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips
Yellow	Cut SIX (6) 2 1/2" squares
Red	Cut TWO (2) 2 1/2" x 18 1/2" strips
Red	Cut TWO (2) 2 1/2" x 28 1/2" strips
Binding (Red)	Cut enough 2" x WOF strips and sew together to bind your wall hanging
Batting	Cut approximately a 35" x 25" piece
Backing	Cut approximately a 35" x 25" piece
Button Mad Buttons (www.ButtonMad.com)	SIX (6) sets of FIVE (5) buttons each of farm animals in black and white

Press Toward the Sashing or Border RED fabrics except for the YELLOW squares, and then press toward the YELLOW squares



Finally, create your quilt sandwich with the top, batting and backing and quilt together as desired. Once finished, bind your quilt. Then, sew your Button Mad farm animal buttons into place.
