

## “Table Scraps” Buffet Runner

Quick to make but with hidden gems! Each triangular end of the buffet runner is a pocket with a hot pad holder. The removable hot pad holders have a layer Insul-Bright® between two layers of Warm & Plush® batting to protect any surface.

Fabric requirements include all fabric for the project top, back and binding.

Finished Buffet Runner is 13 1/2" x 52 1/2" Square  
All seams are 1/4"

Press in the direction of the arrows.


Blocks are 12" square finished, 12 1/2" square unfinished.  
Hot pads are 9" square finished, 9 1/2" square unfinished.

“Table Scraps” Buffet Runner


***Read All Instructions before beginning.***

Fabric Requirements	Amount
White	2 yards (includes 14" x 55"* for a non-pieced Backing or 1 yard for a pieced)
Gold	1/2 yard (includes Binding)
Tan	1/4 yard
Red	1/2 yard
Blue	1/2 yard
Warm and Plush® Batting	Baby Quilt size package* (includes enough batting for Buffet Runner & Hot Pads)
Insul-Bright®	2 yards* (includes enough batting for Buffet Runner & Hot Pads)

\*The batting and backing are a few inches bigger than the buffet runner, but is necessary for quilting purposes.



This pattern has been tested, to the best of our ability. If your block does not come out the size shown, please try adjusting your needle position to the appropriate position (left or right) and see if you get the correct block size.




### Cutting Instructions for buffet runner:


Fabric	Cutting Instructions
Red	Cut ONE (1) 4 1/2" square
Red	Cut FOUR (4) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips
Red	Cut ONE (1) 9" square
Blue	Cut FOUR (4) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips
Blue	Cut FOUR (4) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips
Blue	Cut ONE (1) 9" square
Tan	Cut ONE (1) 4 1/2" square
Tan	Cut FOUR (4) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips
Tan	Cut TWO (2) 9 1/2" squares - then cut each square diagonally, corner-to-corner ONE (1) time. You will end up with TWO (2) triangles per square (you only need to use ONE (1)).
Tan	Cut FOUR (4) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" strips
White	Cut FOUR (4) 4 1/2" squares
White	Cut TWENTY-FOUR (24) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips
White	Cut & piece ONE (1) 14" x 54" strip (Backing)
Gold	Cut ONE (1) 4 1/2" square
Gold	Cut & piece enough 2" x WOF strips for Binding the buffet runner
Insul-Bright®	Cut ONE (1) 14" x 54" strip
Warm & Plush Batting®	Cut ONE (1) 14" x 54" strip

### Cutting Instructions for TWO (2) hot pad holders:

Fabric	Cutting Instructions
Red	Cut EIGHT (8) 2 3/4" squares
White	Cut EIGHT (8) 2 3/4" x 5" strips
White	Cut TWO (2) 11" squares (Backings)
Gold	Cut TWO (2) 5" squares
Gold	Cut enough 2" x WOF strips for Binding each hot pad holder
Insul-Bright®	Cut TWO (2) 11" squares
Warm & Plush Batting®	Cut FOUR (4) 11" squares


There are THREE (3) blocks that make up the buffet runner. These instructions are for the CENTER block. Repeat the same instructions for the two remaining blocks, just substituting the different colored fabrics.




Make FOUR (4)



Make TWO (2)



Make ONE (1)




Once you have the three blocks pieced, add the Tan sashing strips both sides of the center block as well as one at each end of the left and right blocks. Then sew the ends to the center block that now has the Tan sashing on two sides.




The ends of the buffet runner are three layers of fabric. First, sew a Tan triangle to each end. Next, press the Red and Blue triangles in half. Run a top-stitch along the pressed sides of each triangle, 1/8" from the fold. Place the Red or Blue triangle on top of the Tan triangle and baste it in place, as close as you can get to the edges of all three triangles.

Create your quilt sandwich with your buffet runner on top, a layer of Insul-Bright®, a layer of Warm & Plush® then the backing. Pin together and quilt as desired.

Bind your buffet runner in Gold fabric.



There are TWO (2) hot pad holders on the ends of the buffet runner. This page of instructions is for the hot pads that slip into (or out of) those hot pad holders. Make the TWO (2) hot pads exactly alike.



Create your quilt sandwich with your hot pad on top, a layer of Warm & Plush®, a layer of Insul-Bright®, another layer of Warm & Plush® then the backing. Pin together and quilt as desired.

Bind your hot pads in Gold.
