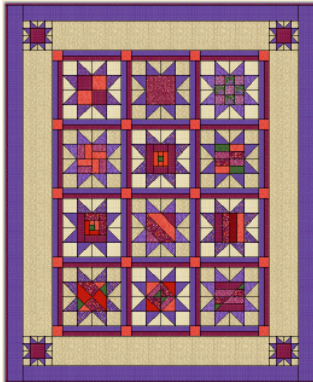


"Strippin' With the Stars" 2008 BOM Quilt

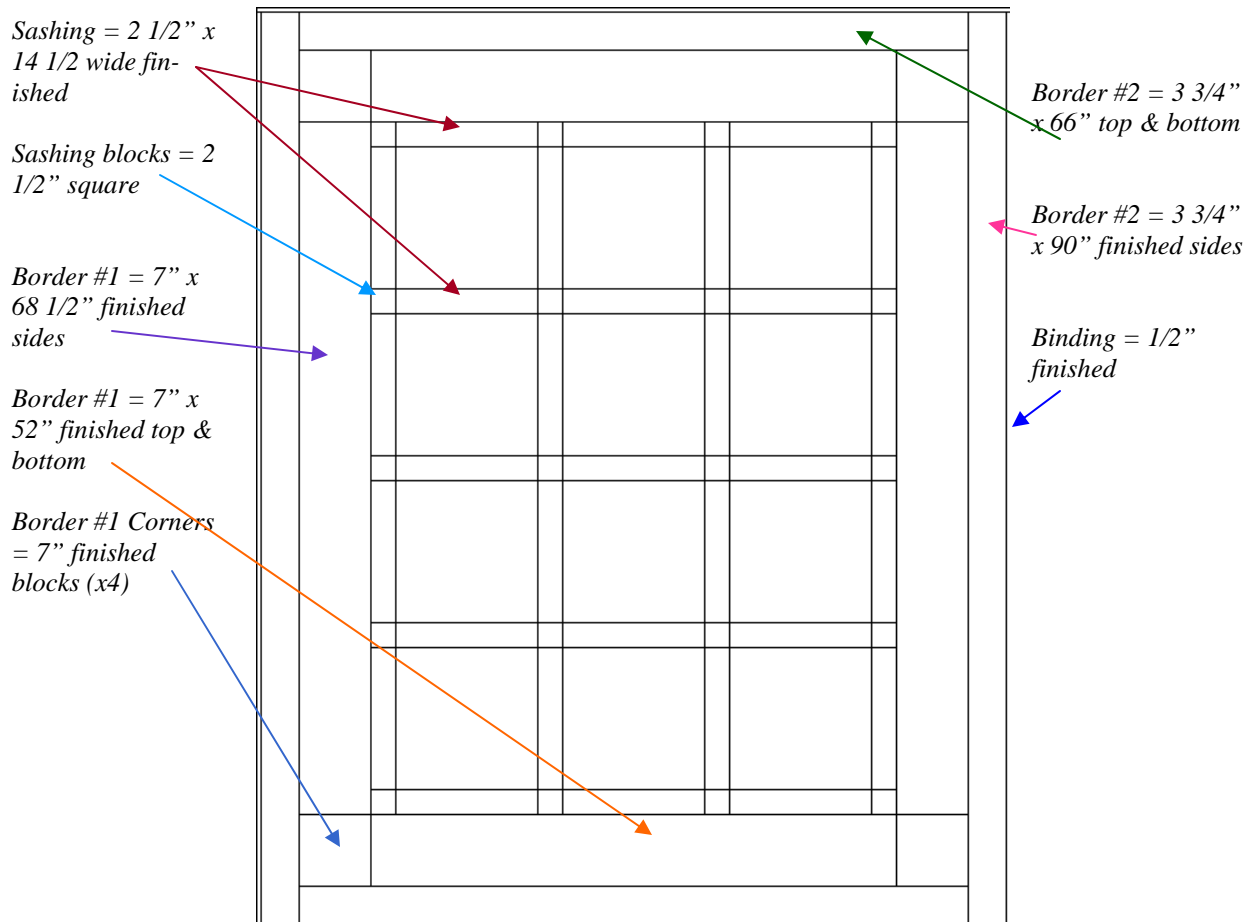
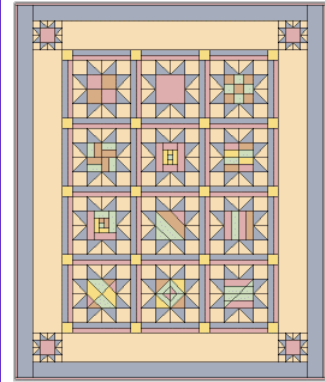

Finishing Instructions



The key to finishing your "Strippin' with the Stars" quilt top is below. The sashing is made with a 1 3/4" x 14" strip of light and dark fabric, sewn together to create 3" x 14 1/2" sashing strips (this includes the seam allowance). You will need 31 of these strips total. Then, cut 20 - 3" squares out of another fabric (bright) for the sashing blocks. The instructions for the 7" finished Border #1 Corner Blocks are on the following page.

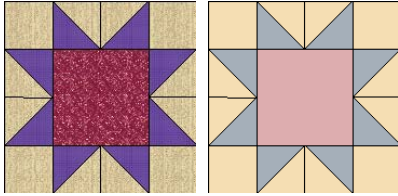


Remember to add 1/2" to all finished measurements, for your seam allowances!

Finishing Instructions



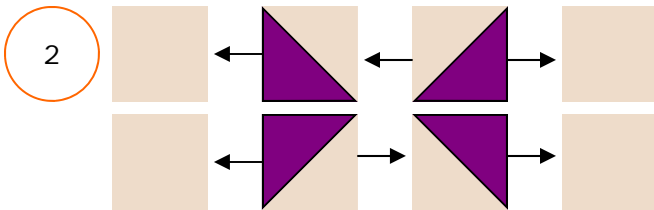
Finished Corner Blocks to Measure 7" square.
 Unfinished Corner Blocks to Measure 7 1/2" square.

Fabric	Cut
Ecru	Cut FOUR (4) 2 1/4" squares
Ecru	Cut FOUR (4) 2 5/8" squares
Purple	Cut FOUR (4) 2 5/8" squares
Maroon	Cut ONE (1) 4" square

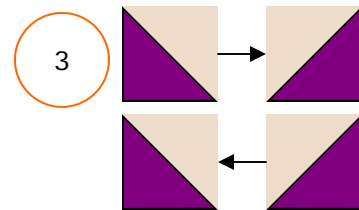

 Make TWO (2) - for a total of FOUR (4) finished half-square triangles.

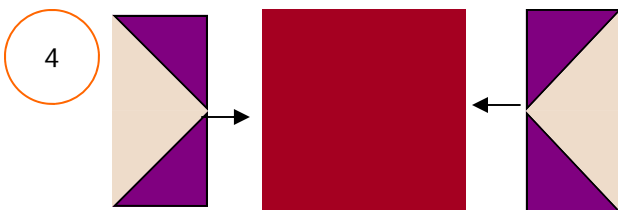
Draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, on the back side of the Ecru squares. Then, sew these TWO squares to TWO of the Purple squares, 1/4" on EACH SIDE of the line you drew. Once done, cut the half-square triangles apart ON the line you drew and press FOUR (4) to the purple fabric and press FOUR (4) to the Ecru fabric. As you put the blocks together in #2 below, be sure to watch the direction you've pressed your fabric so the seams all lay down nicely.

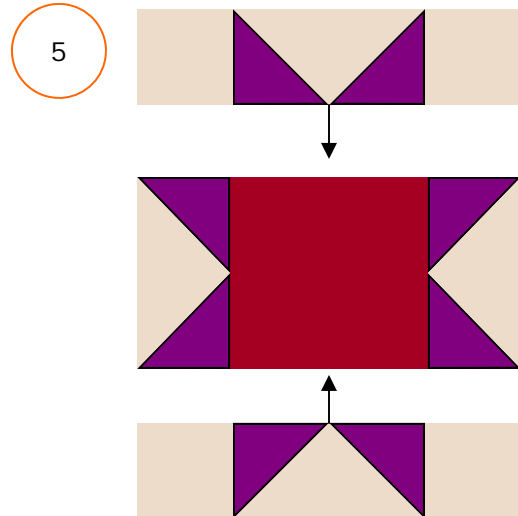
