



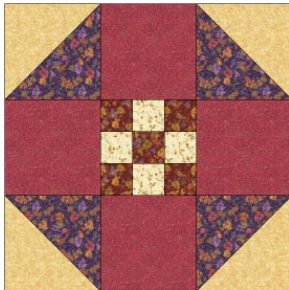

Finished Quilt = 60" x 77 1/2"
Finished Block for Quilt = 15"
Unfinished Block for Quilt = 15 1/2"

Fabric: "Bittersweet" Designed by Nancy Halvorsen from Benartex

Since there are a number of colorways in this fabric line, I will use the basic color of the fabric and you use your own ingenuity to choose which fabrics you feel would be the best match for placement. The most important fabrics to keep track of are the focus fabrics and light fabrics in the half-square triangles at the corners of each of your blocks. They are not used elsewhere except in the sashing and borders.



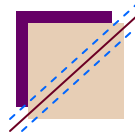

Cutting for Block 11:

Light Fabric	Cut TWO (2) 5 7/8" squares - draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, on the back of each of these squares
Purple Focus Fabric	Cut TWO (2) 5 7/8" squares
Maroon Fabric	Cut FOUR (4) 5 1/2" squares
Purple Fabric	Cut FIVE (5) 2 1/8" squares
Orange Fabric	Cut FOUR (4) 2 1/8" squares

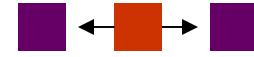

Make TWO (2)

Place the Light square on the Purple focus fabric square and sew 1/4" on EACH side of the line you drew. Then, cut the half-square triangles apart ON the line you drew. You will end up with TWO (2) half-square triangles for each pair of squares you sew together. Press toward the darkest fabric.

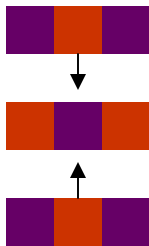

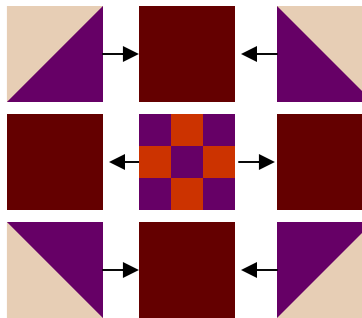

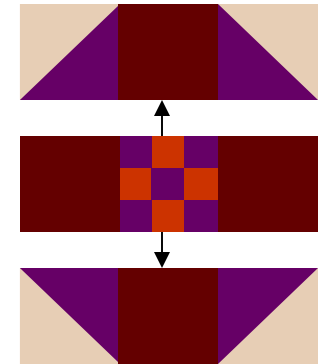
