



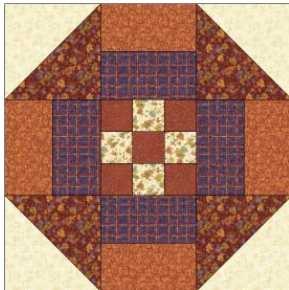

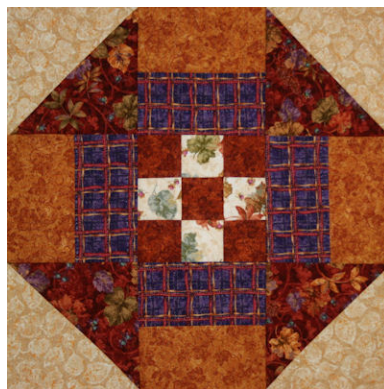
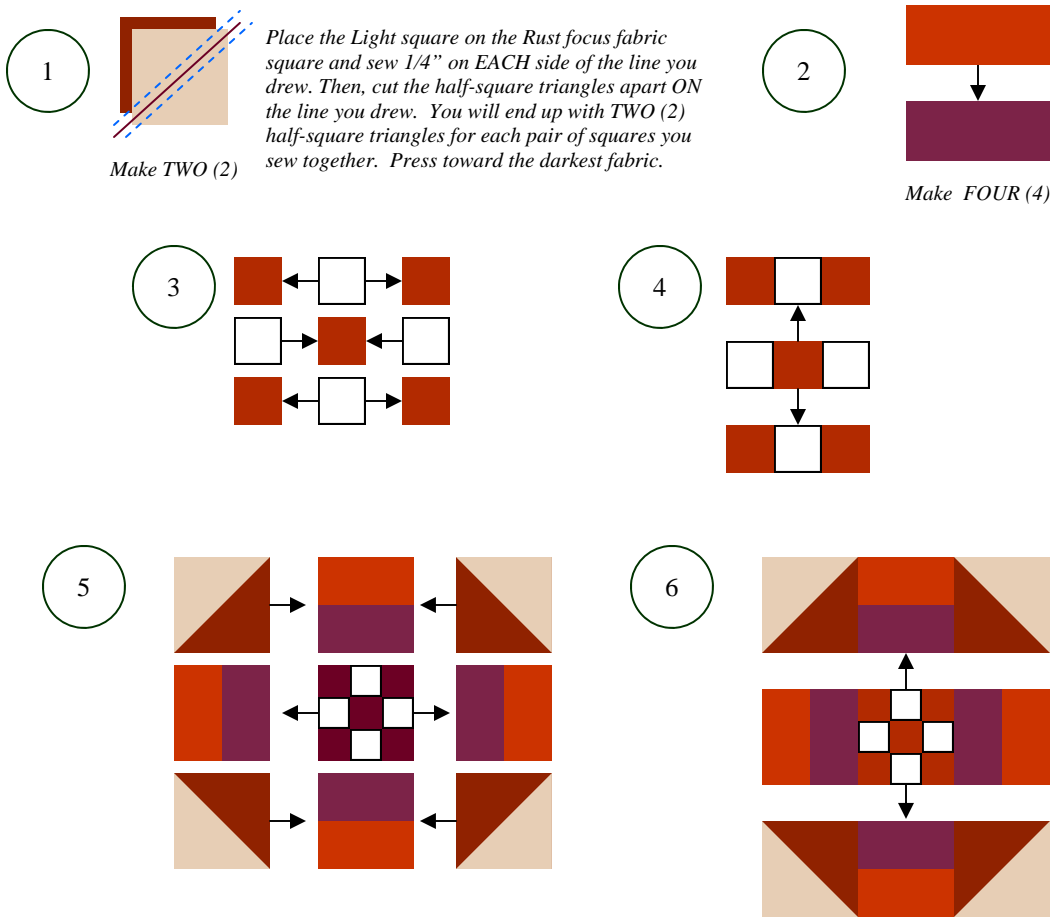
*Since there are a number of colorways in this fabric line, I will use the basic color of the fabric and you use your own ingenuity to choose which fabrics you feel would be the best match for placement. The most important fabrics to keep track of are the focus fabrics and light fabrics in the half-square triangles at the corners of each of your blocks. They are not used elsewhere except in the sashing and borders.*

Block 8*

Cutting for Block 8:	
Light Fabric	Cut TWO (2) 5 7/8" squares - draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, on the back of each of these squares
Rust Focus Fabric	Cut TWO (2) 5 7/8" squares
Orange Fabric	Cut FOUR (4) 3" x 5 1/2" strips
Purple Fabric	Cut FOUR (4) 3" x 5 1/2" strips
Rust Fabric	Cut FIVE (5) 2 1/8" squares
Light Fabric	Cut FOUR (4) 2 1/8" squares
