Pieced & Appliquéd Blocks

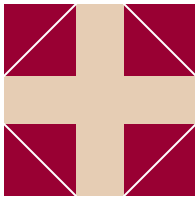
Finished Block Size = 8 1/2"
Unfinished Block Size = 9"



Center Block - Cutting Instructions - Make ONE (1)		
Fabric C - Cream	Cut ONE (1) 9" square	n/a
Fabric D - Dark Red	Cut FOUR (4) 3 5/8" squares	Draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time on the back of each Fabric D Block

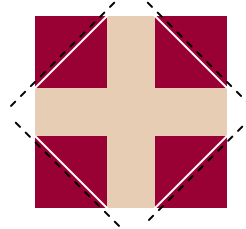
Piecing Instructions

With right sides together, sew the Fabric D squares to the Fabric C square ON the line you drew.

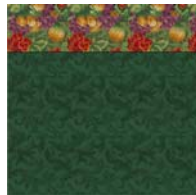


Once sewn, cut away the corners, 1/4" from the seam you made on each corner. Press the Fabric D corners out.

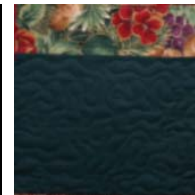


Once sewn, cut away the corners, 1/4" from the seam you made on each corner.

Middle Side Blocks - Cutting Instructions for ONE (1) Block - Make ONE (4)	
Fabric A - Fruit on Green	Cut ONE (1) 6 7/8" x 9" strip
Fabric B - Green	Cut ONE (1) 2 5/8" x 9" strip

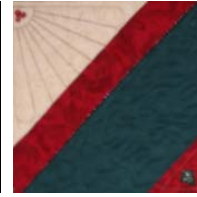

Pieced & Appliquéd Blocks

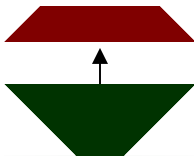
Finished Block Size = 8 1/2"
Unfinished Block Size = 9"



Corner Blocks - Cutting Instructions for ONE (1) Block - Make ONE (4)		
Fabric C - Cream	Cut ONE (1) 7 5/8" square	Cut the square diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. You only need ONE (1) of these triangles for this block.
Fabric D - Dark Red	Cut ONE (1) 1 3/4" x 14" strip	Cut a 45° angle at EACH END of this strip.
Fabric D - Dark Red	Cut ONE (1) 3 5/8" square	Cut the square diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. You only need ONE (1) of these triangles for this block.
Fabric B - Green	Cut ONE (1) 4 1/2" x 14" strip	Cut a 45° angle at EACH END of this strip.

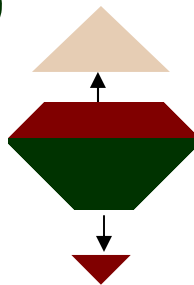
Piecing Instructions

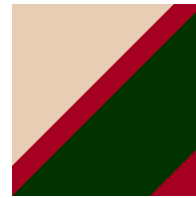


Sew the Fabric D strip to the Fabric B strip, press toward the Fabric D strip.

Border & Binding Cutting	
Fabric D - Dark Red	Cut FOUR (4) 3 1/2" squares
Fabric A - Fruit on Green	Cut FOUR (4) 3 1/2" X 26" strips
Fabric D - Dark Red	Cut enough 2 1/2" x WOF strips to create your binding (they will need to be sewn together)

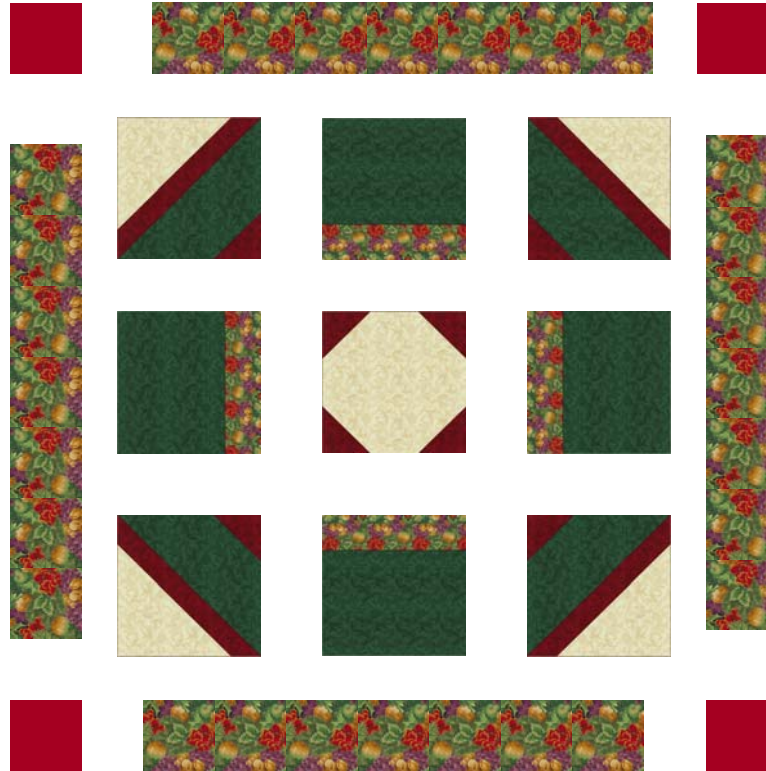

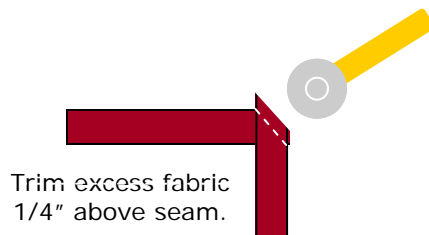
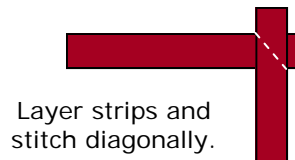
Finished Block Size = 8 1/2"

Binding Your Quilt

1) Sew enough 2" x width of binding fabric strips together as shown, to go around your quilt:

2) With wrong sides together, fold binding in half lengthwise and press. Pin binding to the front edge of the quilt and sew in place using a 1/4" seam (see 1 below). When you reach a corner, stop stitching 1/4" from the edge and fold the binding up and away from the quilt (2). Fold the binding back down and begin stitching again, 1/4" from the folded edge (3).

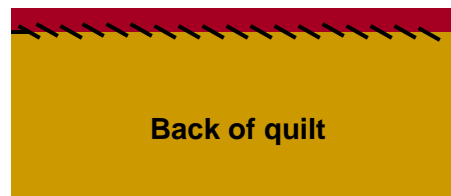

4) Sandwich your quilt front, batting and backing together, right sides of fabric facing out. Fold the binding over the raw edges of the quilt so that the folded edge covers the row of stitching on the back. Using a needle and thread, whip-stitch the binding in place.

Embellishing Your Wall Hanging Quilt

We added our embellishments AFTER the wall hanging was quilted and finished.

1. 3 red mini buttons sewn to each cream corner and 3 red mini buttons were sewn to the center of the quilt
2. Using a string of mini red beads (shown in red dots below), we attached them to the outside perimeter of the green portion of the wreath
3. Using a string of mini gold beads (shown in gold dots below), we attached them to the inside of the cream center
4. Using 1" green Christmas tree buttons, they were adhered to the center of each red border corner
5. Using 1/2" green Christmas tree buttons, they were adhered to the center of the small dark red triangles found in the 4 corner blocks
