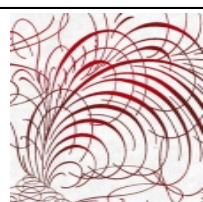
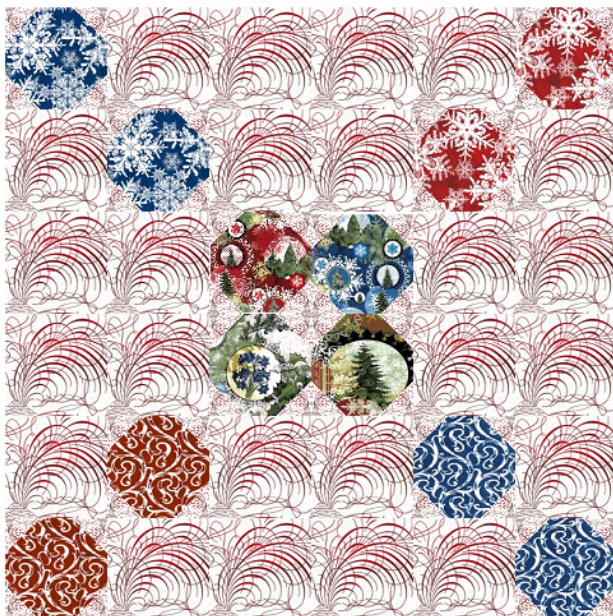

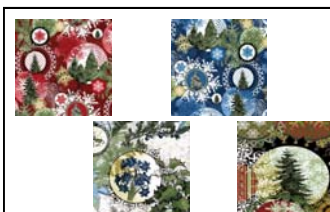


**Completed Quilt Size: 55" square ~ 9" finished blocks**

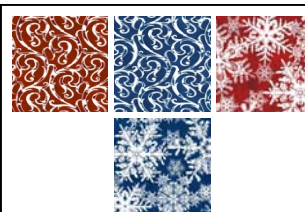
*Fabric requirements include the quilt top, borders and binding. Press in the direction of the arrows.*



**2 1/2 yards**  
**Red Swirl (includes**  
**binding) 5WGB1**



**1/8 yard each of the following:**  
**1WG1, 2WGB1, 1WGB2 & 2WGB2**



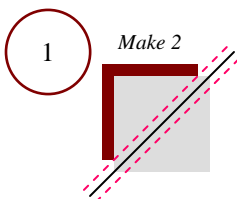
**1/4 yard each of the following:**  
**4WGB1, 4WGB2, 8WG1 &**  
**8WG2**

*You will need **ONE (1)** Snowball Nine-Patch block for each fabric listed above in the 1/8 yard section, and **TWO (2)** Snowball Nine-Patch blocks for each fabric listed above in the 1/4 yard section. The cutting and sewing instructions are the same for all Snowball Nine-Patch blocks. Finished size of block is 9" square, unfinished size is 9 1/2" square. You will also need **TWENTY-FOUR (24)** 9 1/2" squares cut of the Cold Comfort fabric.*



**Snowball Nine-Patch Block**

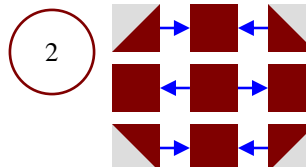
Fabric	Cut for <b>EACH</b> Snowball Nine-Patch Block
WintergraphixII	TWO (2) 4 3/4" squares
Red Swirl	TWO (2) 4 3/4" squares
WintergraphixII	FIVE (5) 4" squares

*Make 2*

*Draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, on the back side of the Red Swirl 4 3/4" squares. Place the squares on the 4 3/4" Wintergraphix II squares (right sides together) and sew 1/4" on EACH side of the line you drew. Then, cut the half-square triangles apart ON the line you drew. You will end up with TWO (2) half-square triangles for each pair of squares you sew together. Press toward the darkest fabric.*

**Remember to make the correct number of Snowball Nine-Patch blocks, as noted above! You should end up with a total of TWELVE (12) Snowball Nine-Patch blocks out of the various "Wintergraphix II" Fabrics!**

This pattern has been tested, to the best of our ability. If your block does not come out the size shown, please try adjusting your needle position to the appropriate position (left or right) and see if you get the correct block size.

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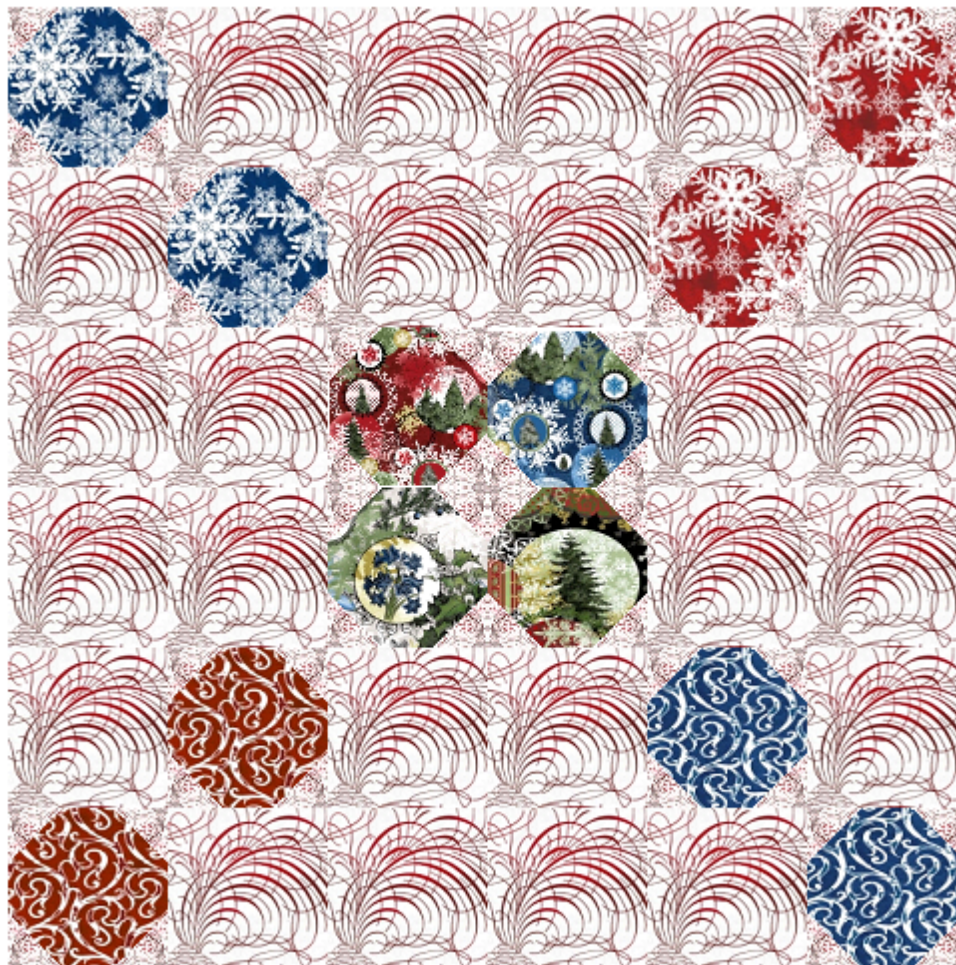

Completed Quilt Size: 55" square ~ 9" finished blocks

*Fabric requirements include the quilt top, borders and binding. Press in the direction of the arrows.*



*Put your quilt top together in the design shown above, with the single Snowball Nine-Patch blocks in the center and the double Snowball Nine-Patch blocks placed as-shown. Press your blocks by rows, in opposite directions.*

*For your binding, cut 2 1/2" x WOF strips and sew together until you have enough fabric to bind your quilt top.*

**Now, you may create your quilt sandwich, quilt your top and add the binding!**
