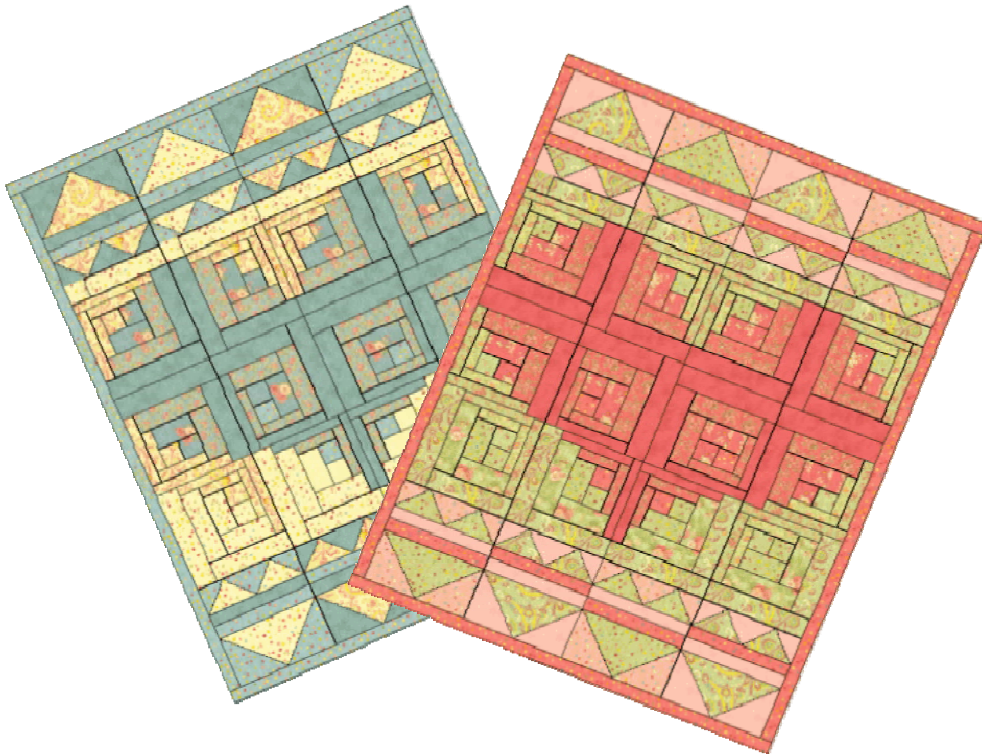

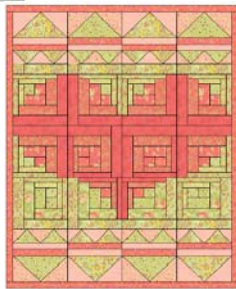
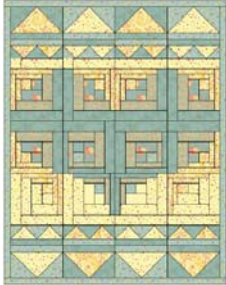

This pattern is going to be written in a generic format, not specifically separated for the various fabrics in your quilt kit. We will try to give you ample instruction as to which fabric you need from your kit, but feel free to email us if you have questions at info@bomquilts.com

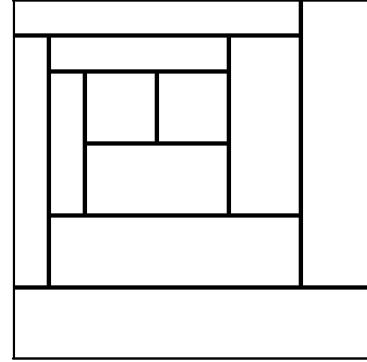
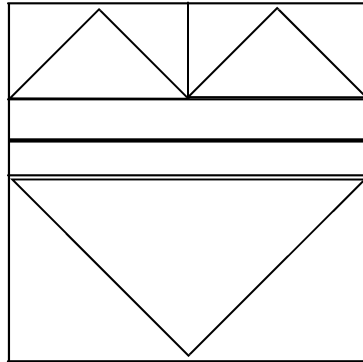
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Basic Block Design: There are two different blocks used in this quilt. One is a heart block on opposite ends of the quilt. The other block is an asymmetrical Log Cabin Block. Here is a diagram of the blocks - which should help you while cutting your fabrics:



Cutting Instructions for FQS Baby Loves Poetry ~ Heart Blocks

Fabric	First Cut	Second Cut
Fabric A - Main Tonal (Pink or Blue) Fabric AA - Main Polka Dot (Pink or Blue)	Cut Four (4) 4 7/8" x 5 1/4" strips from Fabric A & Fabric AA	Draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, on the backside of each of these squares.
Fabric A - Main Tonal (Pink or Blue) Fabric AA - Main Polka Dot (Pink or Blue)	Cut Eight (8) 2 7/8" squares from Fabric A & Fabric AA	Draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, on the backside of each of these squares.
Fabric B - Main Heart (Green or Yellow) Fabric BB - Main Heart Second Color (Green or Yellow)	Cut Eight (8) strips, 4 1/4" x 2 7/8" from Fabric B & Fabric BB. Will end up with eight (8) strips per fabric color.	n/a
Fabric B - Main Heart (Green or Yellow) Fabric BB - Main Heart Second Color (Green or Yellow)	Cut FOUR (4) 5 1/4" x 9 1/8" strip from Fabric B & Fabric BB	n/a
Fabric C - Heart Strip 1 Fabric CC - Heart Strip 1	Cut Four (4) strips 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" from Fabric C & Fabric CC. Will end up with (four) 4 strips per fabric color.	n/a
Fabric D - Heart Strip 2 Fabric DD - Heart Strip 2	Cut Four (4) strips 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" from Fabric D & Fabric DD. Will end up with four (4) strips per fabric color.	n/a

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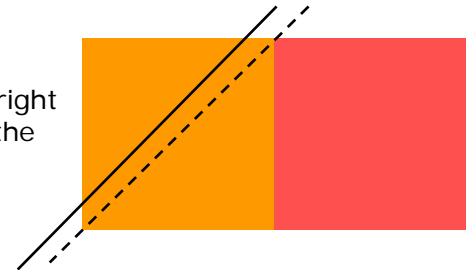
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Piecing Your Blocks

1) Sew your Fabric C & CC strips to your Fabric D & DD strips. Press the Fabric C/D strips toward the Fabric C fabric and press the Fabric CC/DD strips to the Fabric DD fabric. Repeat for a total of four (4) pieces in one color scheme and four (4) pieces in the second color scheme.

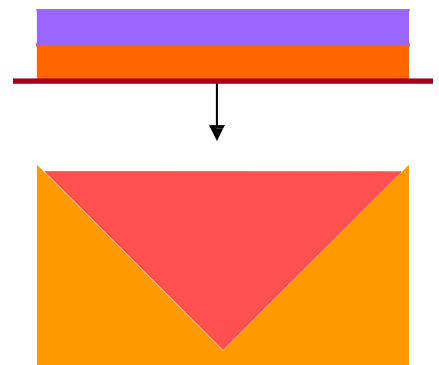


2) Place a 2 7/8" square on one side of the 2 7/8" x 4 1/4" strip, right sides together. Sew the square to the strip ON the line you drew. Cut the excess corner of the fabrics 1/4" from the sewn line. Press toward the triangle. Repeat for the other side of the 2 7/8" x 4 1/4" strip, pressing toward the strip. Repeat for the next 2 7/8" x 4 1/2" strip.

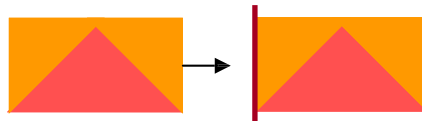


Use these same instructions when sewing the bottom of your heart, utilizing the 4 7/8" x 5 1/4" strips and the 5" x 9 1/8" strips.

3) Sew the strips from #1 to the pieces in #2. Press toward **red line**. Sew two of the strips to the piece with Fabric C or CC sewn to the piece ... sew the other two pieces with Fabric D or DD to the piece. Repeat for a total of four (4) pieces in one color scheme and four (4) pieces in the second color scheme.



1) Sew the pieces from #4 to each other, to create a new row for your block. Press toward the **red lines**. Repeat for a total of eight (8) pieces per color scheme.

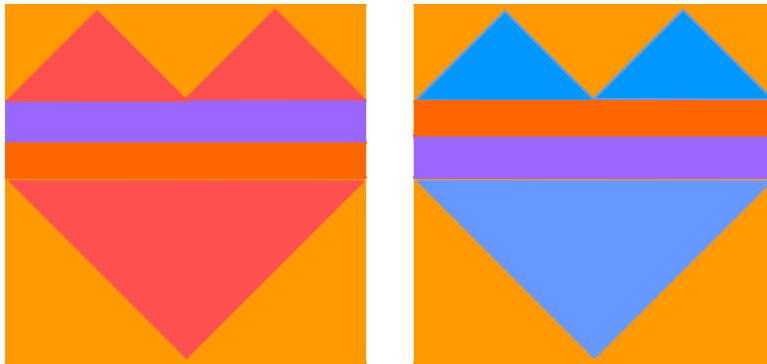


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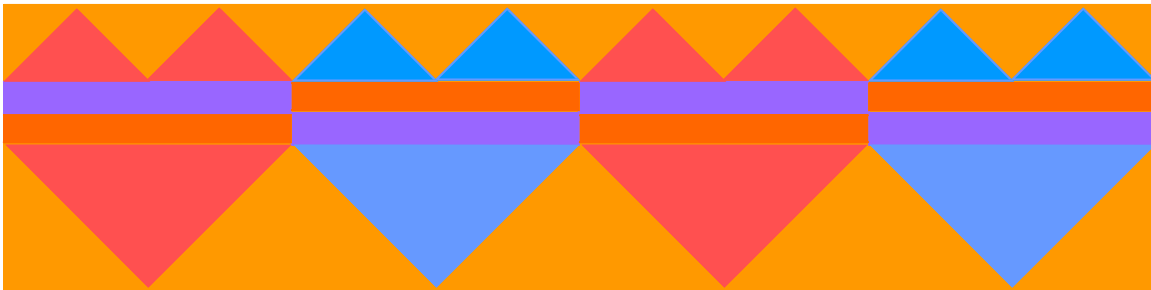
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2) Sew the rows from #5 to the block piece from #2 together. Press toward the long strips. Repeat for a total of eight (8) blocks (four (4) blocks of one color scheme, four (4) blocks of the other color scheme). You will have four (4) heart blocks in each color scheme. Finished block should measure 8 1/2" square.



3) Sew a strip of four (4) of your blocks together, alternating per color scheme. Repeat. Will end up with two (2) strips of heart blocks.
