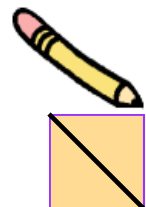
Clue 4

Cutting Your Fabrics for Clue 3

Fabric		Cut 1
Fabric A		Cut 8 squares 6 1/2" x 6 1/2"
Fabric C		Cut 16 square 2 7/8" x 2 7/8"
Fabric H		Cut 8 squares 6 1/2" x 6 1/2"

Marking Your Fabrics for Clue 4

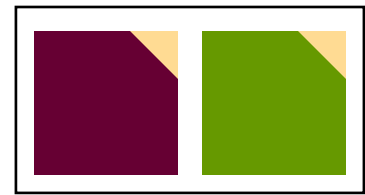
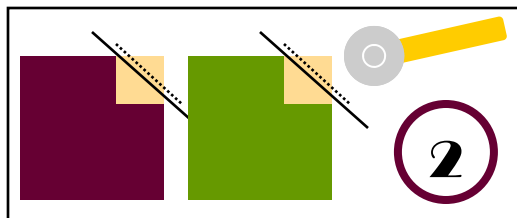
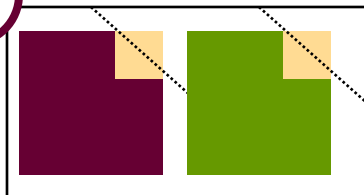
Draw a diagonal line with a washable fabric marker or pencil on the wrong side of each of the 16 Fabric C squares, from one corner to the opposite corner.



Sewing Your Fabrics for Clue 4

1) Sew each of your Fabric C squares to one corner of each of your Fabric A & Fabric H squares on the diagonal line you drew. After sewing, cut the corner of the squares 1/4" from the seam you just made and discard the corner. Press open the Fabric H/C squares toward Fabric C and press open the Fabric A/C squares toward Fabric A.

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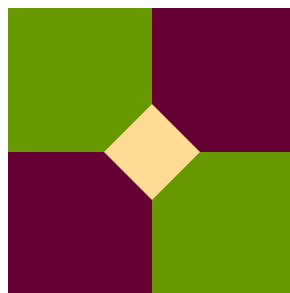

Sewing Your Fabrics for Clue 3

2) Sew your block as shown in steps 1 - 2 below, pressing toward the **red line**. Once done, make three (3) more blocks for a total of four (4) blocks for Clue 4:
