





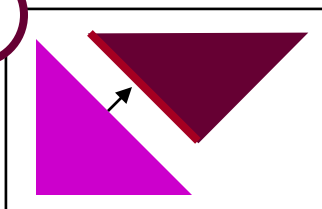
Cutting Your Fabrics for Clue 3

Fabric	Cut 1	Cut 2
Fabric D 	Cut 3 squares 7 1/4" x 7 1/4"	Cut squares from corner to corner twice (end with 4 triangles per square)
Fabric E 	Cut 6 squares 6 1/2" x 6 1/2"	Cut 5 squares from corner to corner one time (end with 2 triangles per square) Cut 3 Cut ONE square from corner to corner twice (end with 4 triangles)
Fabric G 	Cut 5 squares 7 1/4" x 7 1/4"	Cut square from corner to corner twice (end with 4 triangles per square)
Fabric I 	Cut 3 squares 7 1/4" x 7 1/4"	Cut square from corner to corner twice (end with 4 triangles per square)
Fabric J 	Cut 4 squares 7 1/4" x 7 1/4"	Cut square from corner to corner one time (end with 2 triangles per square)

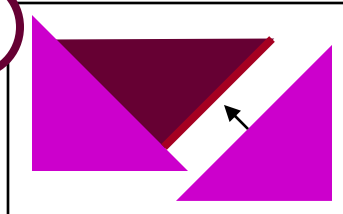
Sewing Your Fabrics for Clue 5

1) Working with the larger Fabric E triangles, sew Fabric G triangles to the two short sides, as shown. Press toward **red line** then clip corners:

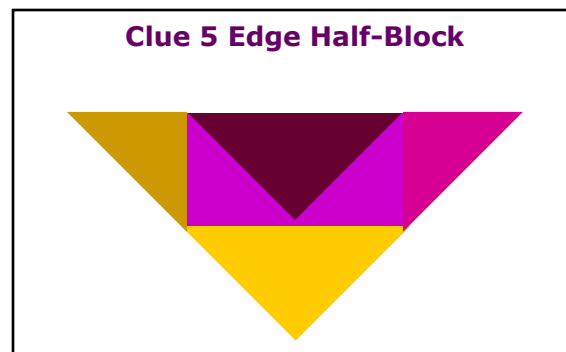
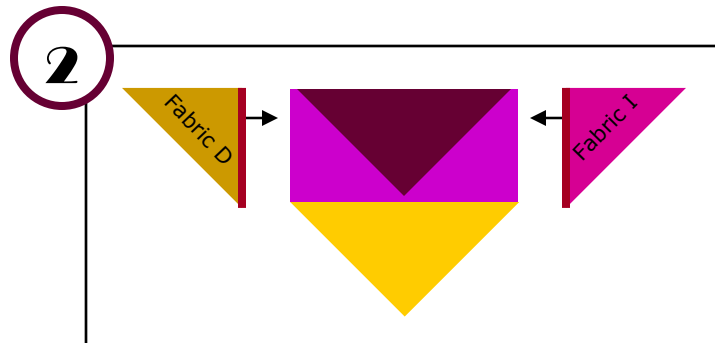
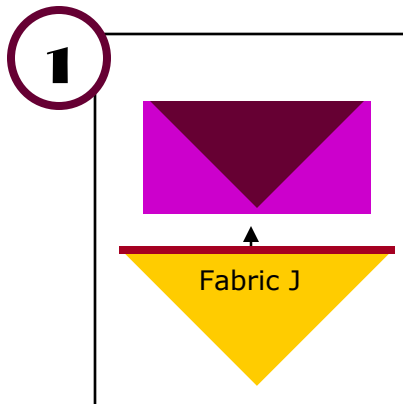

Sewing Your Fabrics for Clue 5

2) Sew your block as shown in steps 1 - 2 below, pressing toward the **red line** and clipping corners as you go. Once done, make seven (7) more half-blocks for a total of eight (8) half-blocks for Clue 5:



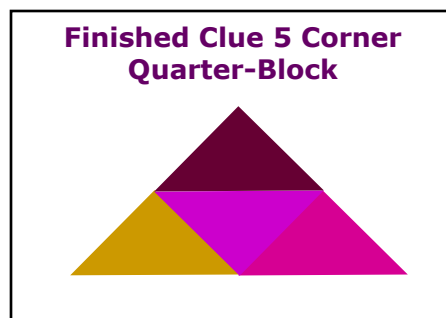
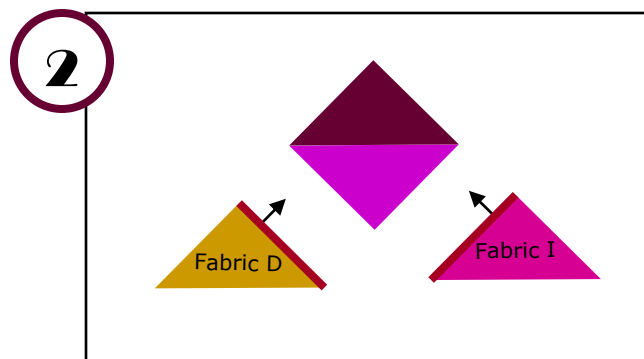
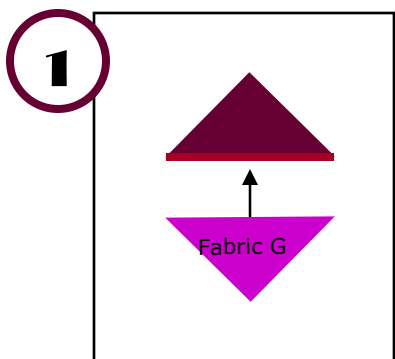

Sewing Your Fabrics for Clue 5

3) Sew your block as shown in steps 1 - 2 below, pressing toward the **red line** and clipping corners as you go. Once done, make three (3) more quarter-blocks for a total of four (4) blocks to finish Clue 5:
