


Quilted Card Wallet

Cutting:

| Number | Fabric | Cut |
|--------|--------------------------------------|---|
| A | Back Fabric (light in photo) | Cut ONE (1) 5" x 10" rectangle |
| B | Inside Fabric (dark in photo) | Cut ONE (1) 5" x 10" rectangle |
| C | Inside Fabric Pocket (dark in photo) | Cut ONE (1) 5" x 8" rectangle |
| D | Clear Vinyl Pocket | Cut ONE (1) 5" x 4" rectangle |
| E | Heavy Stabilizer or Peltex | Cut ONE (1) 5" x 4" rectangle |
| F | Binding (dark in photo) | Cut ONE (1) 1 1/4" x 30" strip (you will need less length than this, but it's good to have a little extra!) |
| G | Batting | Cut ONE (1) 5" x 10" rectangle |

- 1) Begin by preparing your two (2) pockets. Using a 5" strip of your Fabric F Binding, create a piece of bias tape by folding both long sides to the center and then folding again. Sew this to ONE (1) of the 5" sides of the Fabric D clear vinyl by stitching a running stitch about 1/8" from the folded edge, securing the binding to the plastic. 

NOTE: DO NOT PRESS THE VINYL, it will melt!

- 2) Now, you'll need the Fabric C and the Fabric E Heavy Stabilizer / Peltex. Fold Fabric C in half so that you have 5" x 4" showing with right sides out and press the fold in place. Next, slide your stabilizer / Peltex between the two layers of fabric and sew a running stitch across the folded edge, securing the three layers together, about 1/8" from the folded edge. 

- 3) It's time to quilt! Prepare your three layers of the quilted wallet sandwich and baste together. Use your imagination to quilt them together - or just run a straight stitch down the center. Then, lay the layers together, as shown ... pin together ... and bind with the Fabric G binding strip!
