

# TT Mistletoe In The Corner Quilt

A Mistletoe Mooch Just in Time for Christmas!

## Finishing

December 15, 2006

8" block = 33" x 33" finished wall hanging

12" block = 53" x 53" finished lap quilt

**NOTE:** We are not going to tell you what specific fabrics to use, we want to let your creative juices flow! We will use the following fabric names for the cuts – brown, red, cream, peach & green from the "Mistletoe Manor" fabric line by 3 Sisters for Moda Fabrics.

### Cutting Instructions for 8" blocks

Fabric	Cut 1	Cut 2
Red	Cut eight (8) 8 5/8" x 2 5/8" strips ----- Cut 2 5/8" x width of fabric strips for outer sashing	----- You will need to sew these together so that you end up with four (4) strips that are at least 33" long
Green	Cut four (4) 8 5/8" x 2 5/8" strips	
Cream	Cut four (4) 2 5/8" x 2 5/8" squares	
Brown	Cut four (4) 2 5/8" x 2 5/8" squares	

### Cutting Instructions for 12" blocks


Fabric	Cut 1	Cut 2
Brown	Cut eight (8) 12 5/8" x 3 5/8" strips ----- Cut 3 5/8" x width of fabric strips for outer sashing	----- You will need to sew these together so that you end up with four (4) strips that are at least 33" long
Green	Cut four (4) 12 5/8" x 3 5/8" strips	
Cream	Cut four (4) 3 5/8" x 3 5/8" squares	
Red	Cut four (4) 3 5/8" x 3 5/8" squares	

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## Piecing Instructions for Blocks

(all seams 1/4")


Now, it's time to sew all of your hard work together! There is no secret to completing the quilt. It will work best if you make sure you press your seams toward the sashing strips.

Sew your cream squares to the ends of 3 of your green strips.

Sew the final cream square to the end of one of your green/cream square strips.

Now, sew 1 plain green strip to one side of your block and follow the block around with your green/cream squared strips.

Sew the red sashing to the two left blocks on the top and bottom rows and then sew them together with the far right block.

Finally, sew the left and right blocks to the center block and sew the rows together. Follow the same process as shown in #3 above for the outer sashing border, using the long red strips you made and the brown corner squares.

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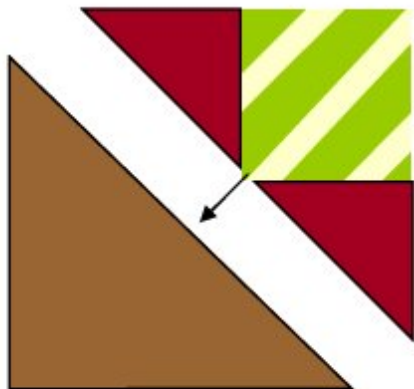
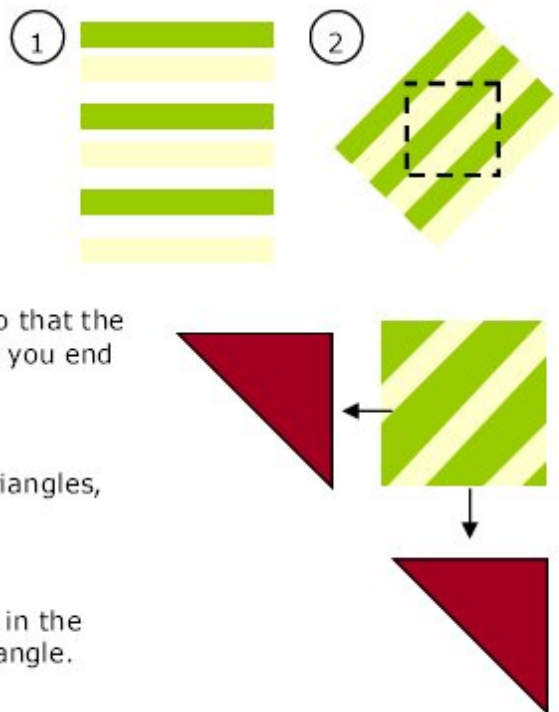
## Piecing Instructions for Blocks

(all seams 1/4")

1) This is probably a bit unconventional compared to most pattern instructions, but I take the simplest way to quilting as is possible! Sew your cream and green strips together. It's easiest if you sew all of your strips together, alternating the colors. Press seams in either direction. Then, square up your block so that the strips run diagonally, and cut the block so that you end up with a 4 1/2" square for your corner.

2) Sew the candy stripe corner block to the red triangles, as shown, pressing towards the red triangles:

3) Finally, sew your red triangle to your Mistletoe in the Corner triangle, pressing towards the large red triangle.



**Good Job! Time to Finish with sashing & borders!**

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
