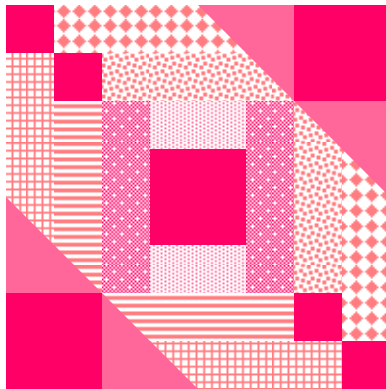

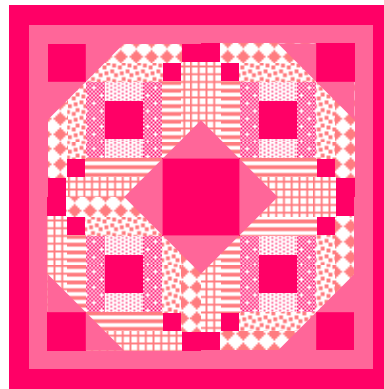

## Fabric For Block Sets - Quilt Pink II from Moda fabrics



*Make FOUR (4) of these blocks*



*Finished Quilt Layout*

**PS:** We are not going to tell you what fabrics to use where. There are dark pink, medium pink, light pink and white backgrounds for the Quilt Pink II fabrics. Please use your own creativity to determine which fabrics to use where.

**PSS:** If your block does not measure as it should, please feel free to move your needle position one direction to the right or left on your sewing machine.

**PPSS:** This pattern has been tested for accuracy. If you find an error, please let us know! We hope there aren't any, but we're only human.

## Cutting Instructions for EACH Block (make FOUR (4) blocks for the TT Pinkie Promise Baby Quilt)

Fabric	Jelly Roll or Charm Pack	Cut
Dark Pink	Charm Pack	ONE (1) 5" square
Dark Pink	Charm Pack	Cut TWO (2) 4 1/2" squares
Dark Pink	Jelly Roll	Cut FOUR (4) 2 1/2" squares
Medium Pink	Charm Pack	Cut TWO (2) 5" squares diagonally, corner-to-corner - ending with TWO (2) triangles per square
Light Pink	Jelly Roll	Cut TWO (2) 2 1/2" x 5" strips
Medium Pink	Jelly Roll	Cut TWO (2) 2 1/2" x 9 1/2" strips
Any Pink	Jelly Roll	Cut EIGHT (8) 2 1/2" x 11 1/2" strips

## Piecing Instructions for EACH Block (press in the direction of the arrow & use a 1/4" seam allowance)



Once here, if you measure your block from the center, it should be 16 1/2" across (either top to bottom or left to right). Now, you want to cut this block so that you can fit the two corners in.. Lay your block on your cutting mat and make sure it's straight through the center. You'll be cutting 1/4" on the OUTSIDE of the of the strips you added to the center in #2 on the previous page and discard the corner scraps (X above).

## Finishing Instructions

Fabric	Jelly Roll or Charm Pack	Cut
Medium Pink	Jelly Roll	Cut TWO (2) 2 1/2" x 33 1/2" strips
Medium Pink	Jelly Roll	Cut TWO (2) 2 1/2" x 37 1/2" strips
Dark Pink	Jelly Roll	Cut TWO (2) 2 1/2" x 37 1/2" strips
Dark Pink	Jelly Roll	Cut TWO (2) 2 1/2" x 41 1/2" strips
Medium Pink	Jelly Roll	Enough 2 1/2" strips pieced together to create binding

*Begin by sewing your four blocks together. Next, add the outer borders, in the order shown below. Press toward the arrows. Once done, create your quilt sandwich with the batting and backing, quilt your baby quilt and use your favorite binding techniques to bind the quilt!*
