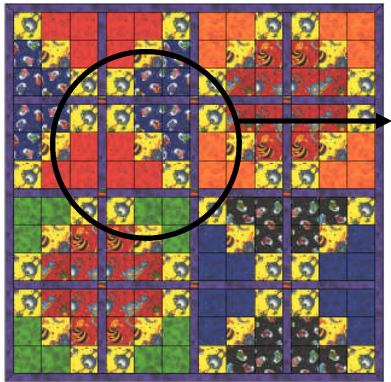


# Sashing Instructions for Quilts

It's time to sew all of your hard work together! There is no secret to completing the quilt except to start sewing your sashing onto the center blocks and work out from there. It will work best if you make sure you press your seams toward the sashing strips.



1

Sew 3 stripe squares to the ends of 3 of your purple strips.

Sew another stripe square to the end of one of your purple/stripe square strips.

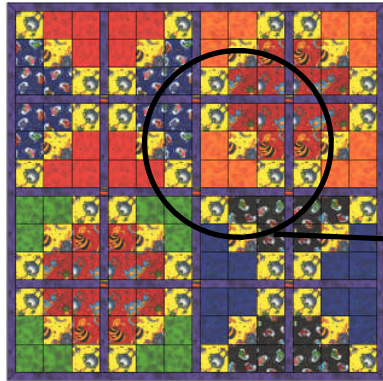
Now, sew 1 plain green strip to one side of your block and follow the block around with your green/cream squared strips.

Finished Block with Sashing

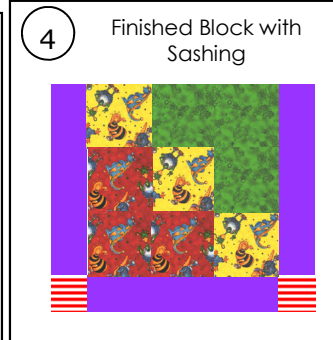
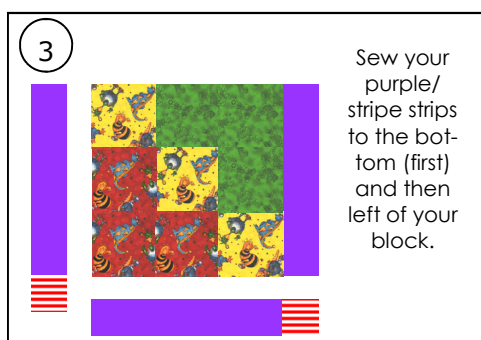
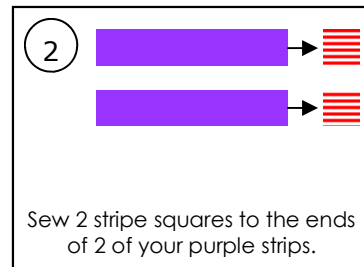
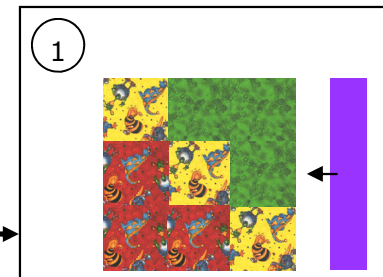
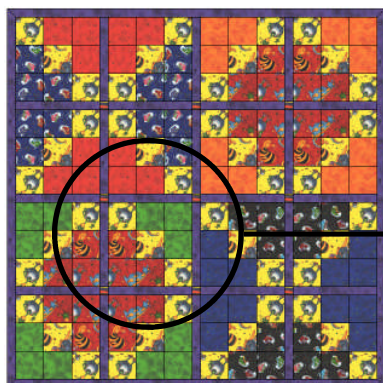
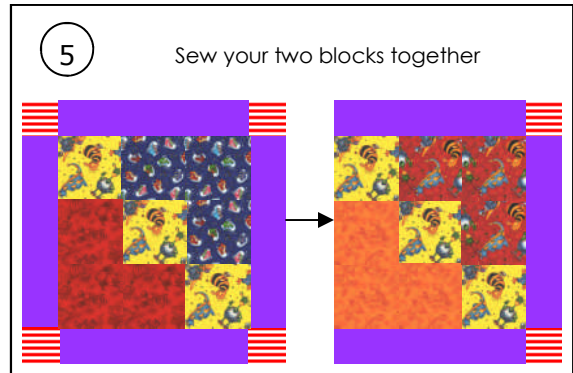
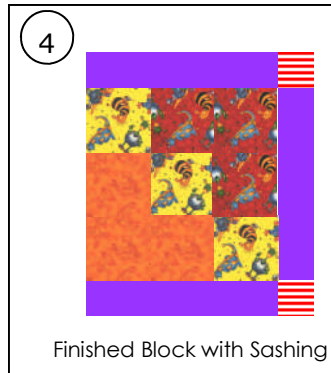
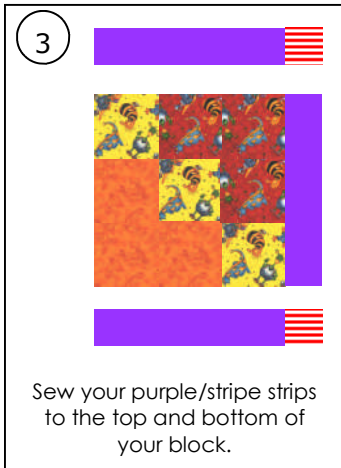
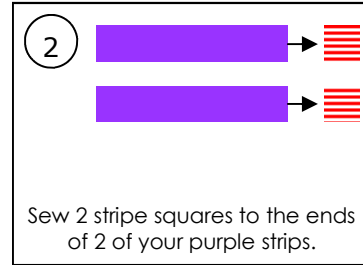
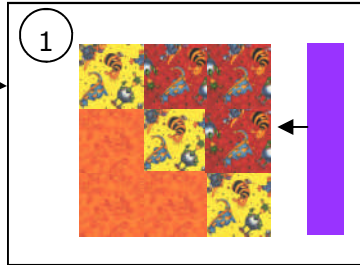

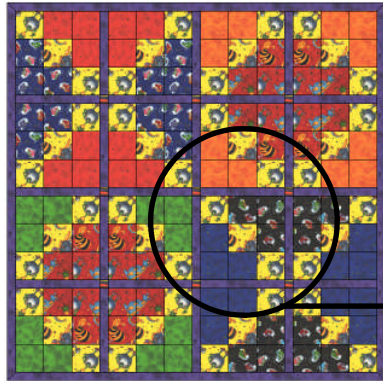
## Piecing Instructions (continued) - all seams 1/4"

To piece the sashing onto the next strip, sew a purple strip to the right side of the block.



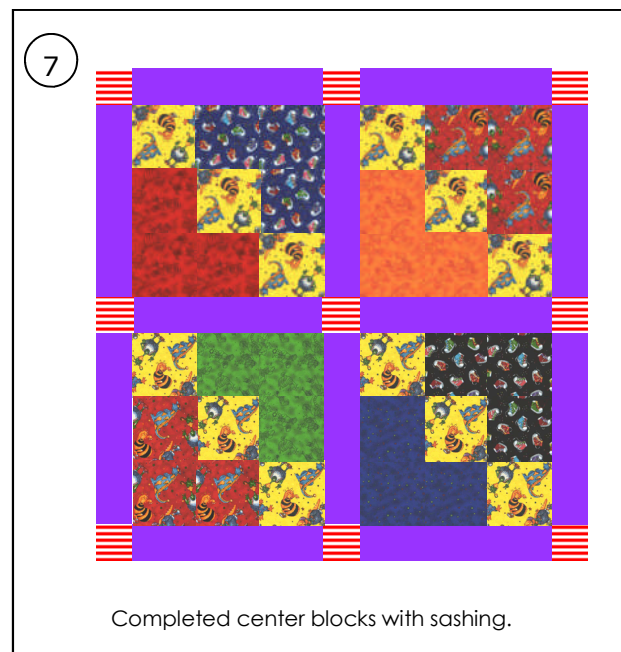
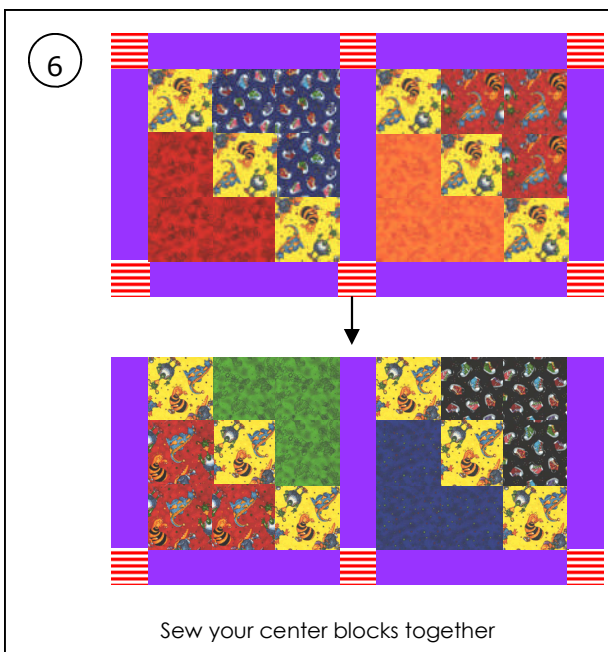
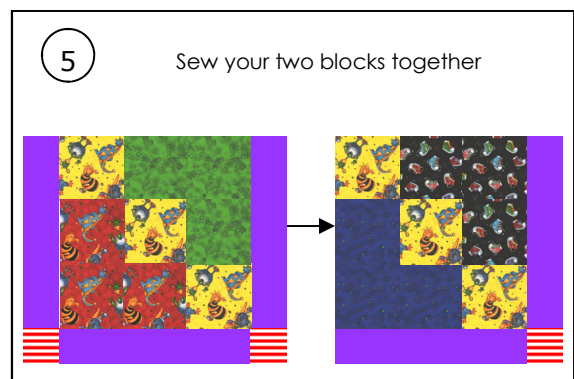
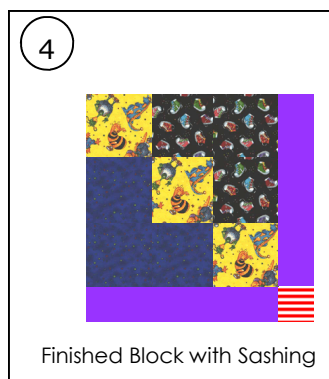
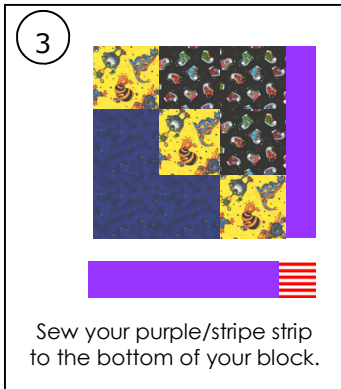
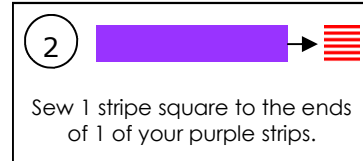
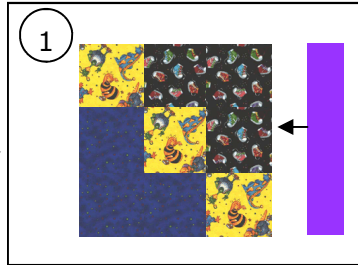

## Piecing Instructions (continued) - all seams 1/4"

To piece the sashing onto the final center block, sew a purple stripe to the right side of the block.

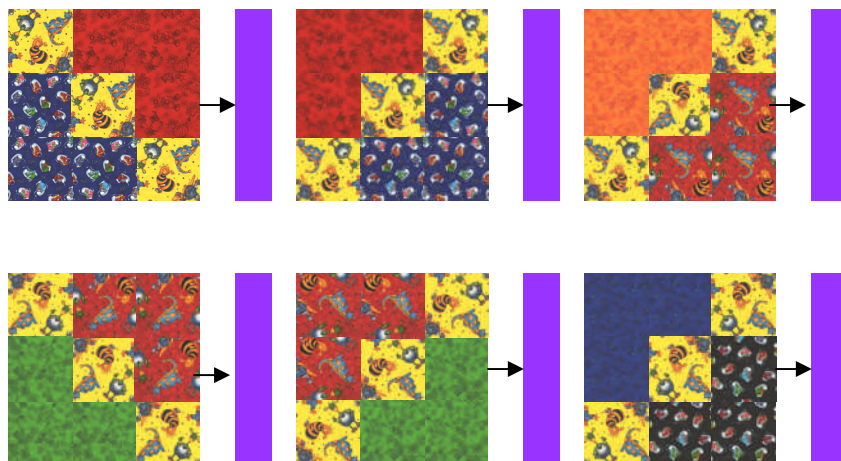

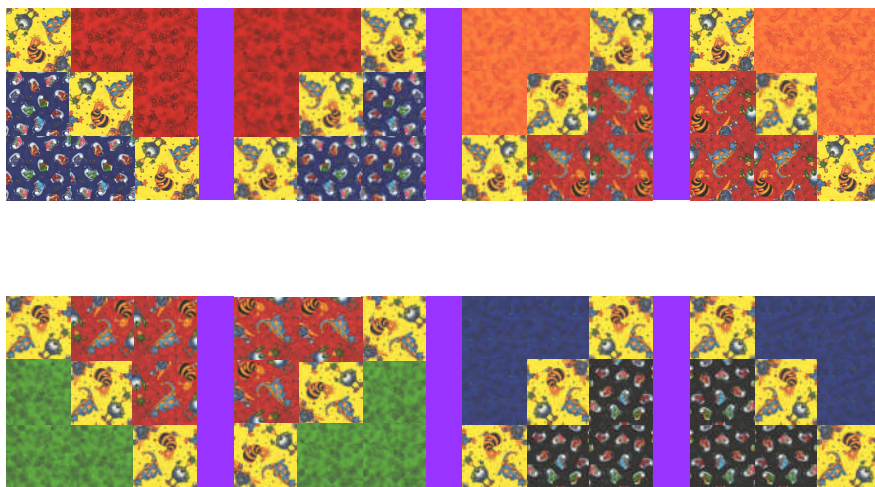

## Piecing Instructions (continued) - all seams 1/4"

Sew the sashing strips to each of the remaining blocks, as shown, pressing towards the strips:



Now, sew your sashed blocks together, with the appropriate unsashed blocks:

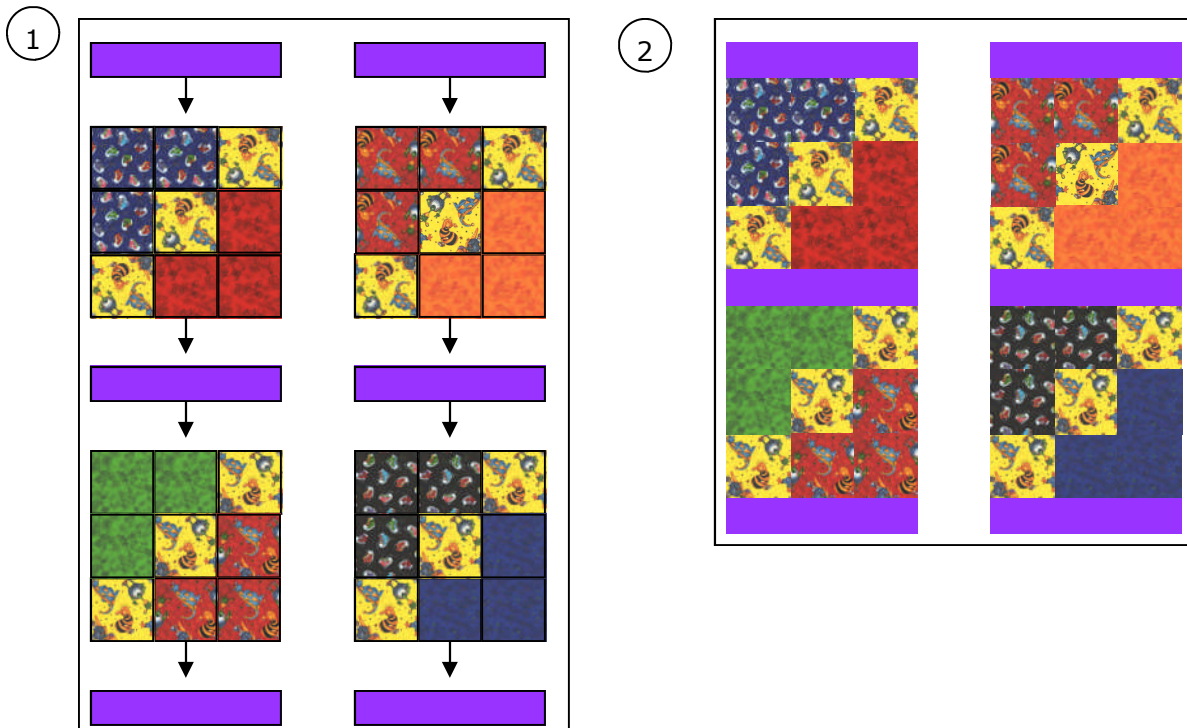

Sew the final four blocks together with the sashing strips, as shown, and then put together:



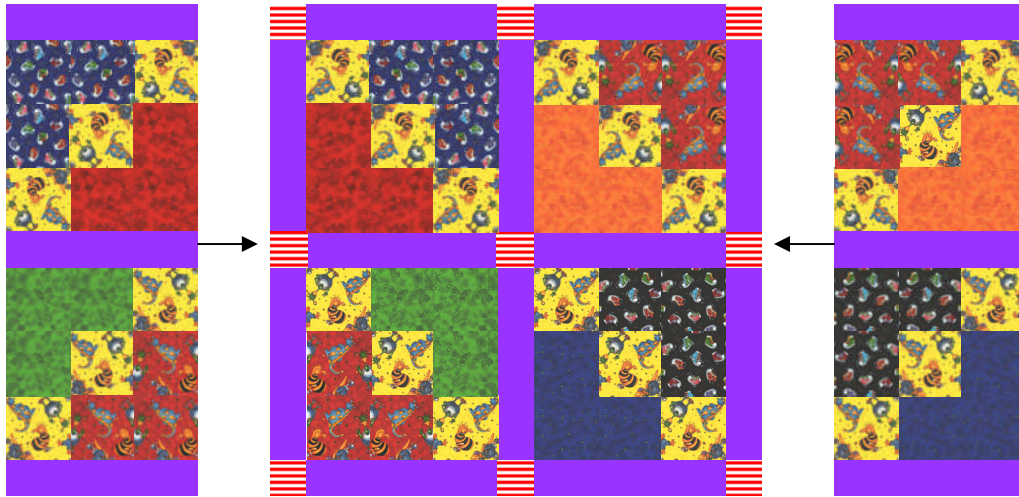

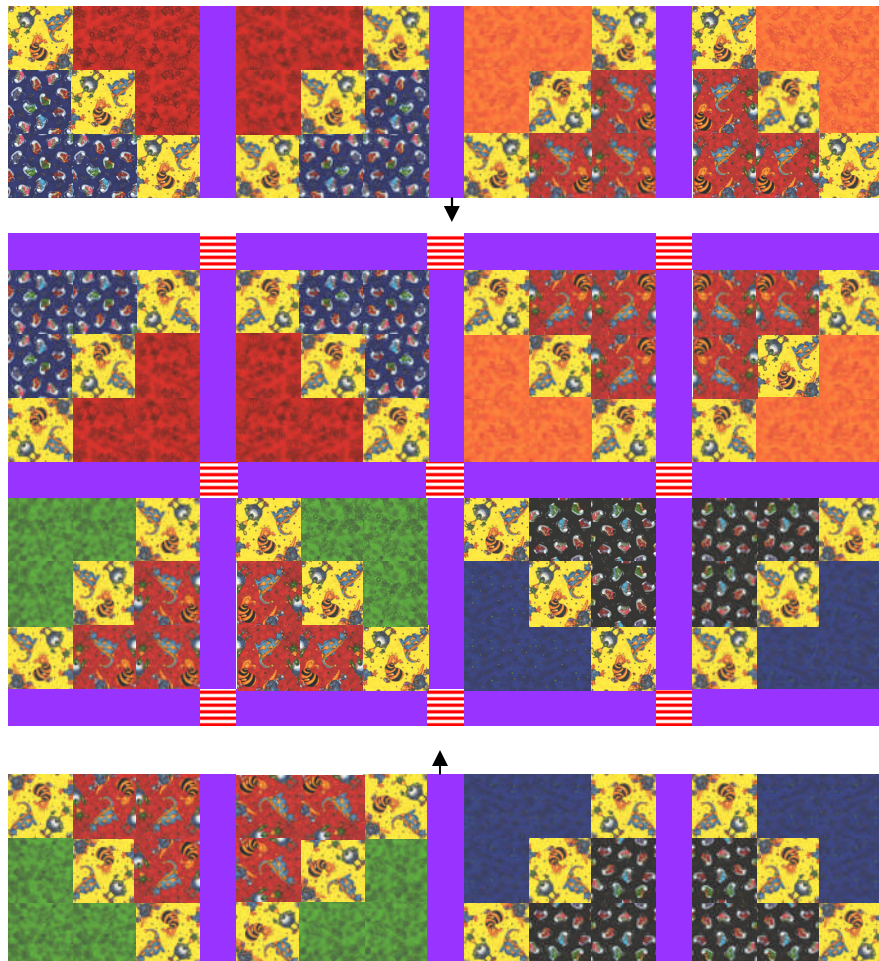

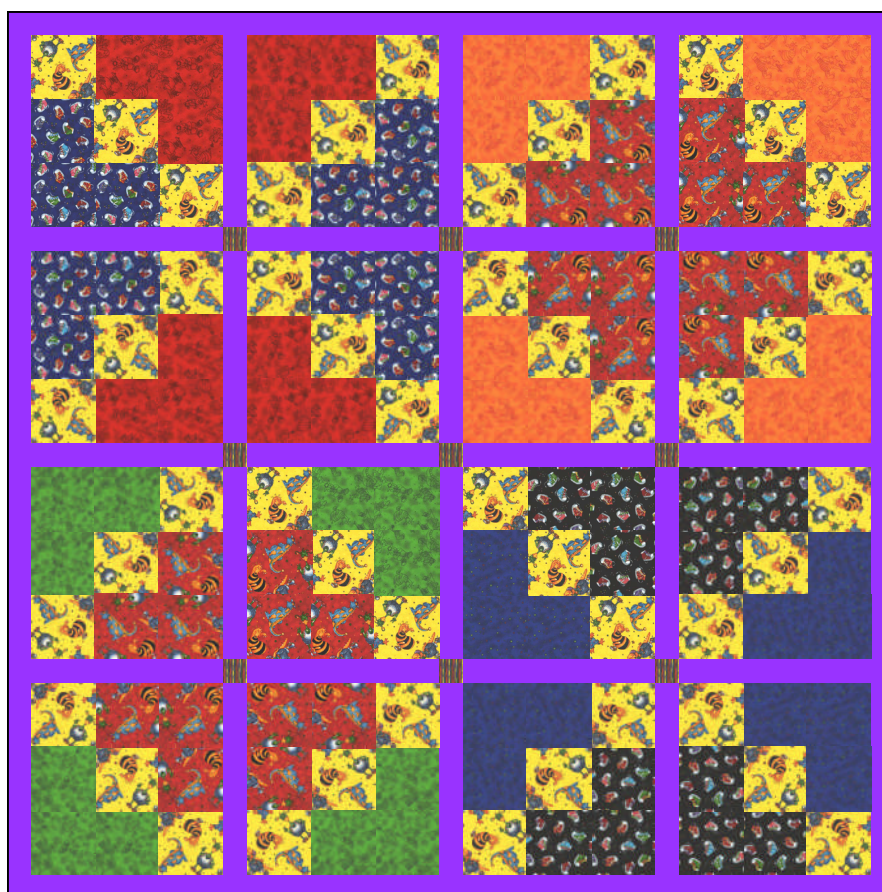

## Piecing Instructions (continued) - all seams 1/4"

Finally, sew the outer border strips together until they are the appropriate length, and sew them to your quilt, top and bottom first, then left and right sides. If you have corner blocks on your outer sashing, then sew them in the same manner as you sewed the squares on your first sashing block:

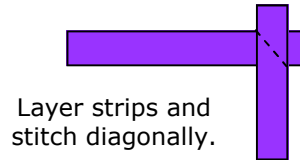

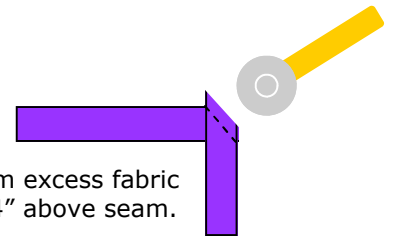

## Binding Your Quilt

1) Sew each of the 2 1/2" x width of fabric G strips together as shown:



Trim excess fabric 1/4" above seam.

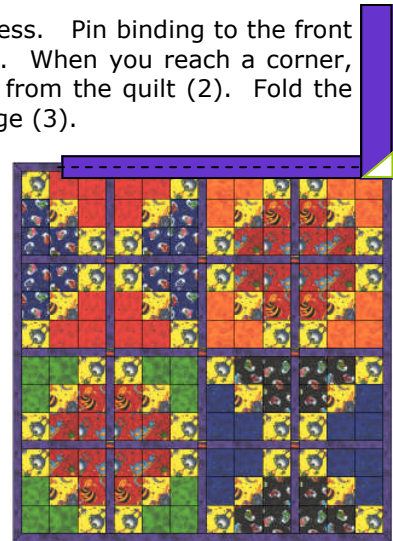


2) With wrong sides together, fold binding in half lengthwise and press. Pin binding to the front edge of the quilt and sew in place using a 1/4" seam (see 1 below). When you reach a corner, stop stitching 1/4" from the edge and fold the binding up and away from the quilt (2). Fold the binding back down and begin stitching again, 1/4" from the folded edge (3).

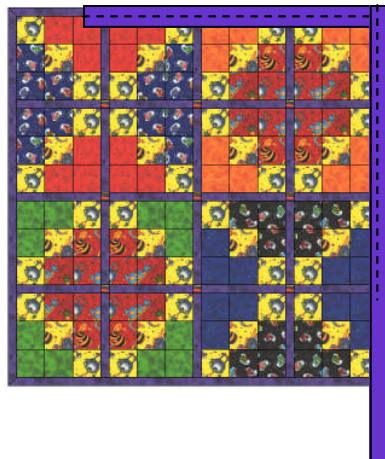

3) Continue stitching the binding to the quilt until you reach the starting point. Overlap the starting edge of the binding by approximately 1" and cut away the excess binding strip. Tuck the end into the fold and finish sewing the binding in place.

4) Sandwich your quilt front, batting and backing together, right sides of fabric facing out. Fold the binding over the raw edges of the quilt so that the folded edge covers the row of stitching on the back. Using a needle and thread, whip-stitch the binding in place.
