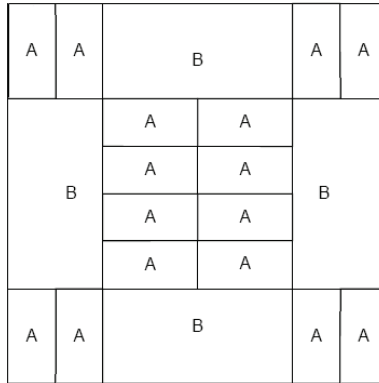
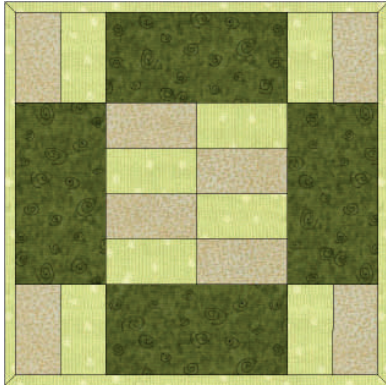


Scrappy Snappy Potholder

Scraps of this 'n that fabric required.

Finished Block Size = 8 1/2"

Unfinished Block Size = 9"

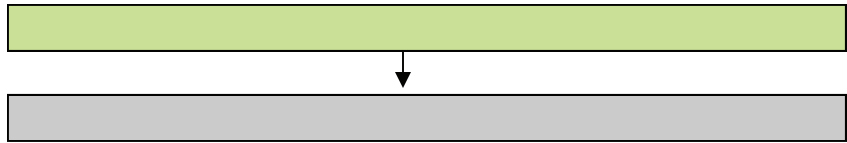
All Seams 1/4"

Potholder is 9" x 9" finished

Cutting:

Number	Fabric	Cut
A	Lt. Grey	Cut ONE (1) 1 1/2" x width of fabric strip
A	Lt. Green	Cut ONE (1) 1 1/2" x width of fabric strip
B	Green	Cut FOUR (4) 2 1/2" x 4 3/4" strips

- 1) Sew your Fabric A strips together along one long side, pressing toward the darker fabric:



- 2) With your mat, ruler & rotary cutter, cut the Fabric A Green/Grey strips so that you end up with EIGHT (8) 2 1/2" squares:



- 3) Put your potholder together, as shown. Press toward the darker green fabric:

Finish your potholder with a 1 1/2" strip of your fabric of choice for binding.

NOTE: ONLY use 100% cotton batting, nothing else will protect your table from the heat.
