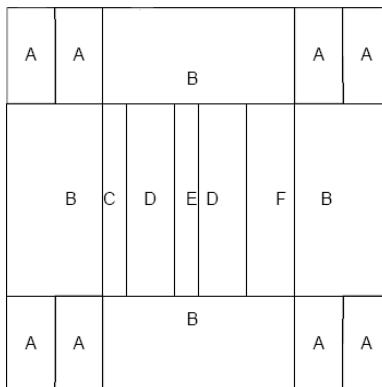
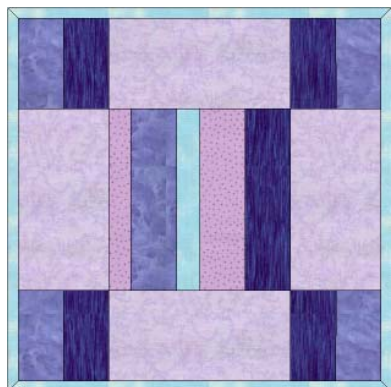


Scrappy Snappy Potholder

Scraps of this 'n that fabric required.

Finished Block Size = 8 1/2"

Unfinished Block Size = 9"

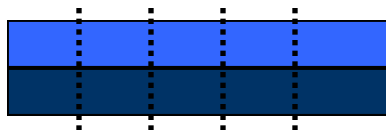
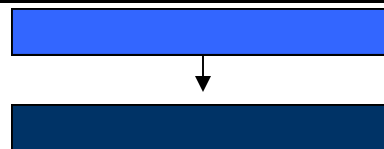
All Seams 1/4"

Potholder is 9" x 9" finished

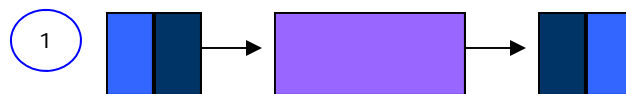
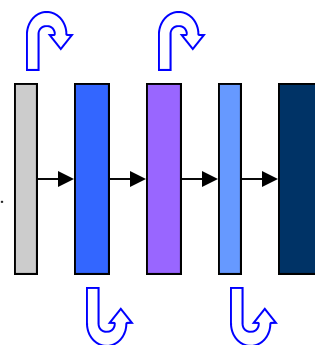
Cutting:

Number	Fabric	Cut
A	Med. Blue	Cut ONE (1) 1 1/2" x 12" strip
A	Dk. Blue	Cut ONE (1) 1 1/2" x 12" strip
B	Lilac	Cut FOUR (4) 2 1/2" x 4 3/4" strips
C	Scrappy Purple	Cut ONE (1) 1" x 4 3/4" strip
D	Med. Blue & Scrappy Lilac	Cut ONE (1) *each* 1 1/2" x 4 3/4" strips
E	Scrappy Blue	Cut ONE (1) 1" x 4 3/4" strip
F	Dk Blue	Cut ONE (1) 1 1/2" x 4 3/4" strip

- 1) Sew your Fabric A strips together along one long side, pressing toward the darker fabric:
- 2) With your mat, ruler & rotary cutter, cut the Fabric A Med/Dk Blue strips so that you end up with EIGHT (8) 2 1/2" squares:



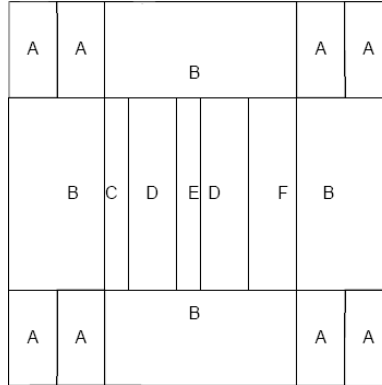
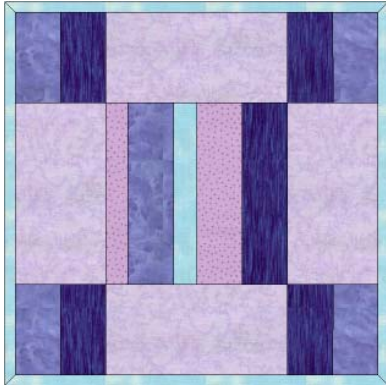
- 3) Sew the center "scrappy" strips together. SEWING NOTE: Sew the first seam starting on one end, sew the next seam starting on the other end and continue sewing in this manner until you have pieced all of your "scrappy" strips together. This will keep your fabric from "curving." Press toward darkest fabric:
- 4) Now, sew your block together, as shown. Press toward fabric B:

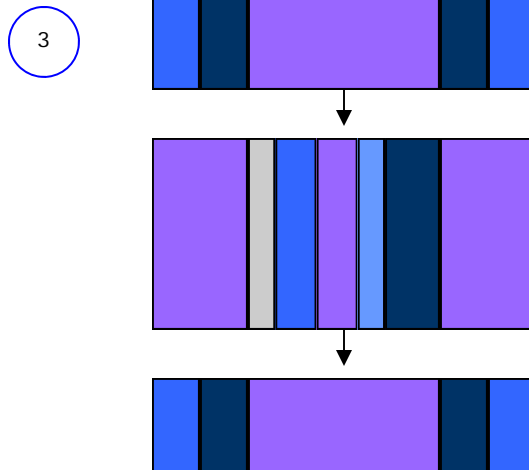
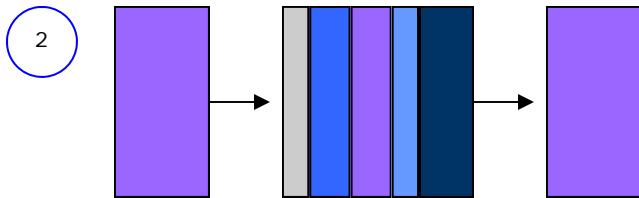
Scraps of this 'n that fabric required.

Finished Block Size = 8 1/2"

Unfinished Block Size = 9"

All Seams 1/4"

Potholder is 9" x 9" finished



Finish your potholder with a 1 1/2" strip of your fabric of choice for binding.

NOTE: ONLY use 100% cotton batting, nothing else will protect your table from the heat.
