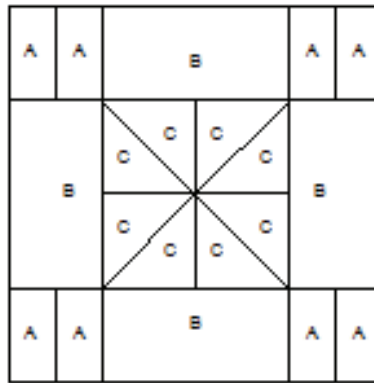


Scrappy Snappy Potholder #4

Scraps of this 'n that fabric required.

Finished Block Size = 8 1/2"

Unfinished Block Size = 9"

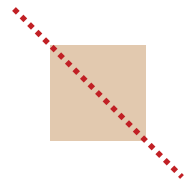
All Seams 1/4"

Potholder is 9" x 9"
Finished with 1/4" binding

Cutting:

Number	Fabric	Cut
A	Light Green	Cut FOUR (4) 2 1/2" x 1 1/2" strips
A	Beige	Cut FOUR (4) 2 1/2" x 1 1/2" strips
B	Red	Cut FOUR (4) 4 3/4" x 2 1/2" strips
C	Dark Green	Cut TWO (2) 3" squares
C	Beige	Cut TWO (2) 3" squares

- 1) Draw a diagonal line, from corner-to-corner, on the back of your Fabric C Beige squares.



- 2) With right sides together, sew the Fabric C Dark Green and Beige squares together, 1/4" on EACH SIDE of the line you drew. Once done, cut the squares apart ON the line you drew. You will end up with two half-square triangles per square. Press toward the Dark Green fabric.



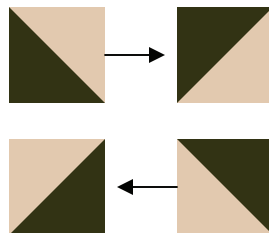
- 3) Now, sew the rest of your potholder together, following the steps shown. Press toward the arrows:

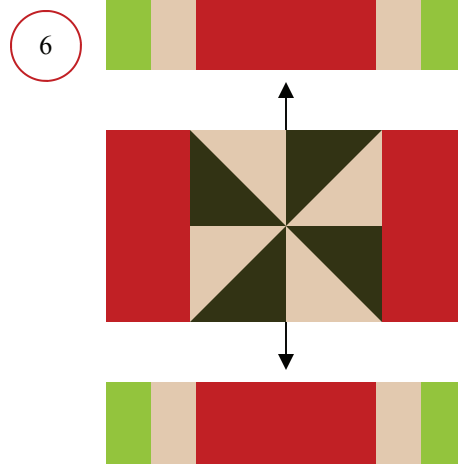
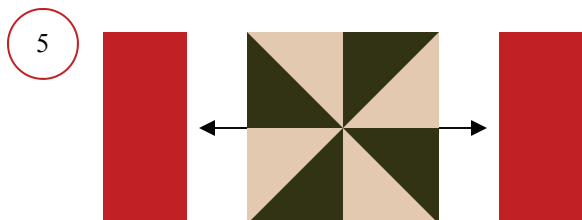
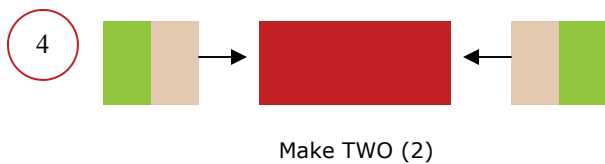
Scraps of this 'n that fabric required.

Finished Block Size = 8 1/2"

Unfinished Block Size = 9"

All Seams 1/4"

Potholder is 9" x 9"
Finished with 1/4" binding



Finish your potholder with a 1 1/2" strip of your fabric of choice for binding.

NOTE: ONLY use 100% cotton batting, nothing else will protect your table from the heat.
