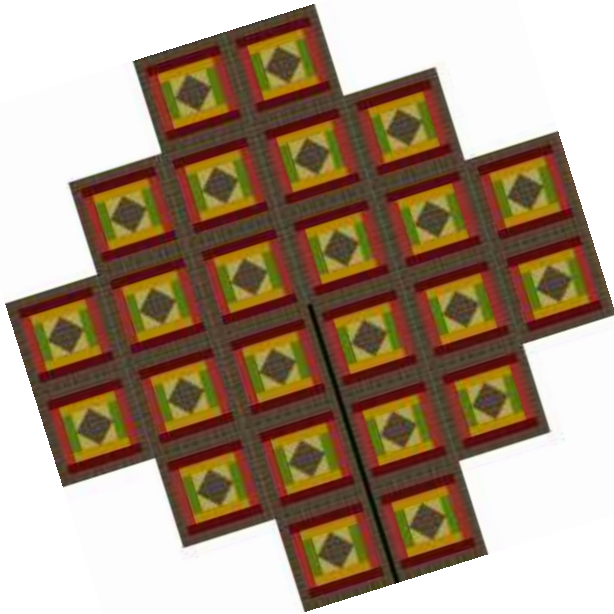


# Log Cabin Courthouse Christmas Tree Skirt

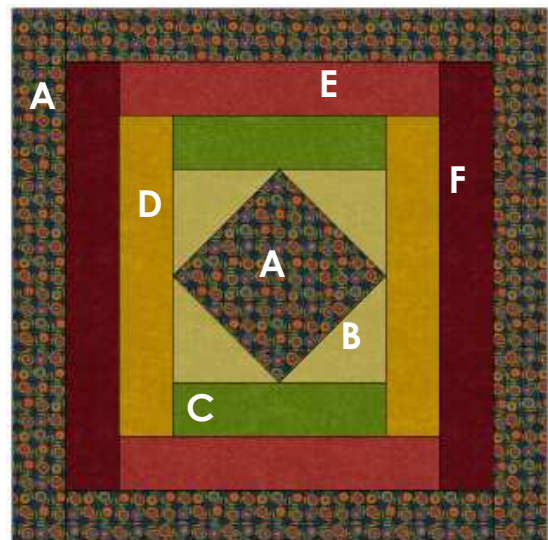

These instructions are for the blocks of the Christmas tree skirt \*only.\*  
Please finish your tree skirt as desired.



## Fabric Key

- Fabric A** - center square and outer strip
- Fabric B** - center block border
- Fabric C** - green strip
- Fabric D** - gold strip
- Fabric E** - pink strip
- Fabric F** - red strip



## Cutting Instructions

Cutting Instructions are for ONE (1) block - you will need to make TWENTY-FOUR (24) blocks for your stocking. Block size unfinished = 8 1/2". Block size finished = 8".

Fabric	First Cut	Second Cut
Fabric A	Cut ONE (1) 2 3/4" x 2 3/4" square	n/a
Fabric A	Cut TWO (2) 1 1/4" x 8 1/2" strips	n/a
Fabric A	Cut TWO (2) 1 1/4" x 6 7/8" strips	n/a
Fabric B	Cut TWO (2) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares	Cut each square diagonally, from corner to corner ONE (1) time - will end up with 4 triangles.
Fabric C	Cut TWO (2) 1 1/4" x 3 3/4" strips	n/a
Fabric D	Cut TWO (2) 1 1/4" x 5 1/2" strips	n/a
Fabric E	Cut TWO (2) 1 1/4" x 5 1/2" strips	n/a
Fabric F	Cut TWO (2) 1 1/4" x 6 7/8" strips	n/a

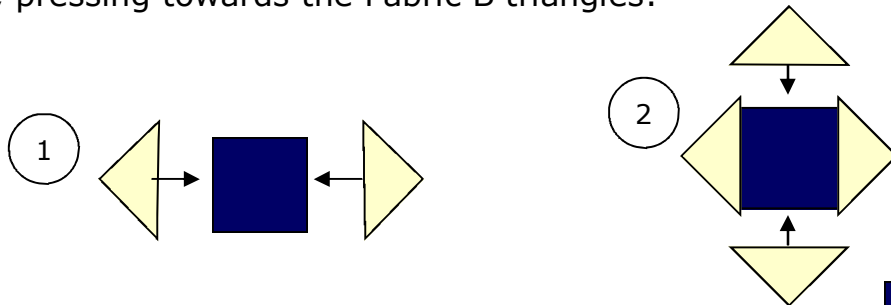
# Log Cabin Courthouse Christmas Tree Skirt

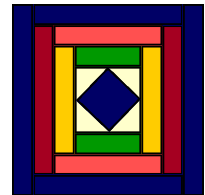
These instructions are for the blocks of the Christmas tree skirt \*only.\*  
Please finish your tree skirt as desired.

## Piecing Instructions

- 1) With right sides together, sew your Fabric B triangles to your Fabric A square, pressing towards the Fabric B triangles:



- 2) Sew the strips to your center block, short strips sewn first on top and bottom, then longer strips. Press toward the strip you sew each time:



- 3) Make TWENTY-FOUR (24) blocks to create your Christmas tree skirt. Then, sew the blocks together as shown. Finish, as desired. Our suggestion is that you sandwich your quilt batting and sew on either side of the opening, right sides together. Then, turn right sides out and quilt your tree skirt - finishing with a border that is whip-stitched on the back:
