All Seams 1/4"
Finished Block for Quilt = 20"
Unfinished Block for Quilt = 20 1/2"
Press in the direction of the arrows. Finished Size: 73" x 96"

This quilt is made using the chain and strip piecing method. If you cut out all of your
fabrics first, then sew them together in strips and then in chains, you can complete this quilt top very quickly!

Fabric requirements includes binding but not backing fabric.

Fabric Requirements:


Colorwash Texture Lime 2 yards


Colorwash Texture Blue 2 yards


Colorwash Hexagons Island Blue 2 1/8 yards


Border Stripe Lime \& Blue 1/4 yard


Colorwash Border Stripe Blue 1/4 yard


Moda Bella Solids Lime 1/4 yard


Moda Bella Solids Teal 1/4 yard

Big Lime Block Make SIX (6)

Fabric Cuts for ONE (1) Big Lime Block - you need to make SIX (6) of these blocks for this quilt.

| Texture Lime | Cut FOUR (4) $3^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips |
| :--- | :--- |
| Texture Lime | Cut FOUR (4) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips |
| Texture Blue | Cut TWO (2) $3^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips |
| Texture Blue | Cut FOUR (4) $21 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips |
| Hexagons | Cut TWO (2) $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips |
| Lime/Blue Stripe | Cut TWO (2) $37 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips |



| Fabric Cuts for ONE (1) Big Blue Block - you need to make SIX (6) of <br> these blocks for this quilt. |  |

| Texture Blue | Cut FOUR (4) $3^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips |
| Texture Blue | Cut FOUR (4) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips |
| Texture Lime | Cut TWO (2) $3^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips |
| Texture Lime | Cut FOUR (4) $21 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips |
| Hexagons | Cut TWO (2) $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips |
| Blue Stripe | Cut TWO (2) $37 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips |

Sashing \& Binding Cuts:

| Solid Lime | Cut THIRTY (30) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares |
| :--- | :--- |
| Solid White | Cut THIRTY-ONE (31) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 201 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips |
| Solid Blue | Cut and piece enough $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips to bind your quilt |

If you need assistance with chain and/or strip piecing, please refer to a search engine to find written and video tutorials.

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## Lydia's Quilt Blocks TWO (2) Colorways

Remember - both blocks are constructed the same way, just pay attention to which Texture Lime and Texture Blue you use and where the Lime and Blue Stripes are placed in relation to the predominant fabric surrounding the Hexagon fabric in each block.

Begin with the strip quilting method for these blocks. One important thing to remember is that you need to mark which end of the fabric you started sewing from as you want to sew the strips in opposite directions to prevent the fabric from curving.


After you have made Textured Green and Hexagon strips, cut them to create a 14" block. Repeat the same process with the Blue Texture strips, except cut them at 7". Remember to repeat the same process with the Blue Texture blocks (see below).


Next we switch to chain piecing to complete the blocks. Chain piecing simply means to run your fabric/blocks through your sewing machine without starting and stopping on each block.

Remember - both blocks are constructed the same way, just pay attention to which Texture Lime and Texture Blue you use and where the Lime and Blue Stripes are placed in relation to the predominant fabric surrounding the Hexagon fabric in each block.


Make TWELVE (12) of these for each Textured color.


Make SIX (6) of these for each Textured color.


## Finishing Lydia's Quilt

Chain piece the sashing by following the image below:
