









#### "Baby Bunting" Baby Quilt

The contrast between light and dark fabrics will certainly catch baby's attention!

Fabric requirements include all fabric for the project top, back and binding.

Finished Quilt is 44" Square

All seams are 1/4"

Press in the direction of the arrows.

Center Block is 30" square finished, 30 1/2" square unfinished.

Fabric Requirements	Amount
Blue	1/2 yard
Green	3/4 yard
Yellow	1/2 yard
White	1 yard (includes binding)
Batting	50" square*
Backing	50" square*

<sup>\*</sup>The batting and backing are a few inches bigger than the quilt, but is necessary if you are going to hand-quilt the quilt or machine quilt (domestic or long arm) it.

If you need assistance with chain and/or strip piecing, please refer to a search engine to find written and video tutorials.










This quilt is made using the chain and strip piecing method. If you cut out all of your fabrics first, then sew them together in strips and then in chains, you can complete this quilt top very quickly!



Fabric	Cutting Instructions
Green	Cut TWO (2) 3 1/2" x WOF strips
Yellow	Cut TWO (2) 3 1/2" x WOF strips
White	Cut FOUR (4) 7" squares - then draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, on the back of the squares
Blue	Cut FOUR (4) 7" squares
Blue	Cut FIVE (5) 6 1/2" squares

Center Medallion

1 | Make TWO (2)

Begin with the strip quilting method.

Once the strips have been sewn together, cut EIGHT (8) 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips and FOUR (4) 6 1/2" squares from the sewn strips.

Now utilize the chain piecing method.





Make FOUR (4) Place the 7" WHITE square on the 7" BLUE square (right sides together) and sew 1/4" on EACH side of the line you drew. Then, cut the half-square triangles apart ON the line you drew. You will end up with TWO (2) half-square triangles per set of WHITE/BLUE squares. Press toward the darkest fabric. Once you have sewn and pressed the half-square triangles, take the half-square triangles to the cutting mat and square them up so they are 6 1/2" square - making sure you clip the corners.












Continue with the chain piecing method to sew the center medallion together.

















#### **Putting the Quilt Together!**



Fabric	Cutting Instructions
Blue	Cut FOUR (4) 2 1/2" squares (border #1 corners)
White	Cut FOUR (4) 2 1/2" x 30 1/2" strips (border #1)
Blue	Cut FOUR (4) 5 1/2" squares (border #2 corners)
Yellow	Cut TWELVE (12) 4 1/2" x 5 1/2" strips (border #2)
Green	Cut EIGHT (8) 5 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips (border #2)
Green	Cut EIGHT (8) 5 5/8" squares (border #2)
White	Cut and piece enough 2" x WOF strips to bind the finished quilt.

#### Press toward the darkest fabric!













#### **Putting the Quilt Together!**



Fabric	Cutting Instructions
Blue	Cut FOUR (4) 2 1/2" squares (border #1 corners)
White	Cut FOUR (4) 2 1/2" x 30 1/2" strips (border #1)
Blue	Cut FOUR (4) 5 1/2" squares (border #2 corners)
Yellow	Cut TWELVE (12) 4 1/2" x 5 1/2" strips (border #2)
Green	Cut EIGHT (8) 5 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips (border #2)
Green	Cut EIGHT (8) 5 5/8" squares
