## Cutting Requirements for table topper - Colors listed are based on the image shown above.

Red Stripe	Cut ONE (1) 10 1/2" square. Then cut this square diagonally, corner-to-corner, TWO (2) times. You will end up with FOUR (4) triangles.
Red Stripe	Cut TWO (2) 2 1/4" x 9 1/2" strips (pieced Border)
Red Stripe	Cut TWO (2) 2" x WOF strips (Binding)
Green Stripe	Cut ONE (1) 10 1/2" square. Then cut this square diagonally, corner-to-corner, TWO (2) times. You will end up with FOUR (4) triangles.
Green Stripe	Cut TWO (2) 2 1/4" x 9 1/2" strips (pieced Border)
Green Stripe	Cut TWO (2) 2" x WOF strips (Binding)
Peppermints on Green	Cut FOUR (4) 2" x 4 1/2" strips
Peppermints on Green	Cut FOUR (4) 2" x 8 1/2" strips
Peppermints on Green	Cut FOUR (4) 2" x 10 1/2" strips
Peppermints on Green	Cut TWO (2) 2" x 11 1/4" strips (pieced Border)
Peppermints on Green	Cut THREE (3) 2" x WOF strips (Binding)
Cookies for Santa Natural	Cut FOUR (4) 2" x 4 1/2" strips
Cookies for Santa Natural	Cut FOUR (4) 2" x 8 1/2" strips
Cookies for Santa Natural	Cut FOUR (4) 2" x 10 1/2" strips
Cookies for Santa Natural	Cut TWO (2) 2" x 11 1/4" strips (pieced Border)
Cookies for Santa	Cut TWO (2) 2" x WOF strips (Binding)

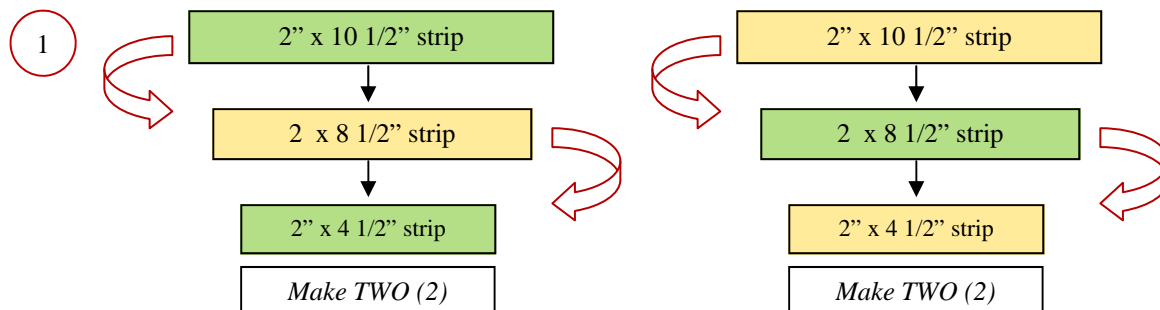

The construction of this block uses my Sew-N-Slash™ process. The strips are longer than their finished size. This gives you the opportunity to trim them to perfection so the points all come together in perfect pieced harmony.

When sewing strips, always remember to sew them in opposite directions. This will reduce the natural curvature of the fabrics. Follow the arrows below to understand this concept.

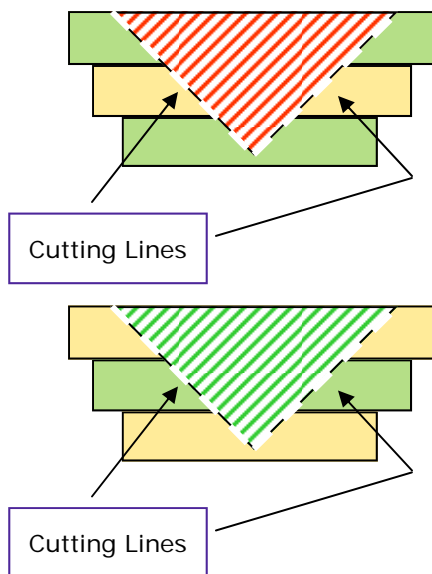

The construction of this block uses my Sew-N-Slash™ process. The strips are longer than their finished size. This gives you the opportunity to trim them to perfection so the points all come together in perfect pieced harmony.

## Now the Sew-n-Slash™ Fun Begins!

Before Sewing a Seam... Pin together, on the long axis, the Red/Green Striped triangle to the Peppermints on Green/Cookies for Santa Natural strips (right sides together), making sure you are centering the triangle on the strips and that the long edge of the longest Peppermints on Green strip/Cookies for Santa Natural is lined up even with the long edge of the Red/Green Striped triangle. Using the Red/Green Striped triangle as your guide, trim the Peppermints on Green/Cookies for Santa Natural strips on each side of the Orange triangle (where you see the White dashed lines on the illustration). Now, discard the excess fabric and remove the pins from the long axis and place them on the RIGHT side of the Red/Green Striped triangle.

Repeat for the remainder of the blocks.
