An original design of traditional sampler quilt squares surrounded by a stunning framed border designed with "Chelsea Lane" fabric by P & B Textiles.

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




Finished Quilt to Measure 48" x 61"

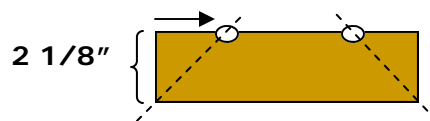
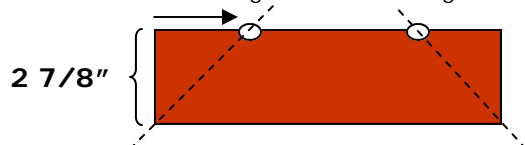
Finished Blocks to Measure 14" x 14"



Cutting Instructions for Block 12

Fabric A	Fabric B	Fabric C	Fabric D	Fabric E	Fabric F
 Cut TWO (2) 3 1/8" squares then cut this square diagonally ONE time. ----- Cut ONE (1) 5 7/8" squares then cut this square diagonally TWO times.	 Cut EIGHT (8) 1 5/8" squares. ----- Cut FOUR (4) 3 1/8" squares then cut this square diagonally ONE time. ----- Cut ONE (1) 5 7/8" squares then cut this square diagonally TWO times.	 Cut EIGHT (8) 1 5/8" squares ----- Cut TWO (2) 3 1/8" squares then cut this square diagonally ONE time.	 Cut FOUR (4) 2 7/8" x 10 1/2" strips then cut the ends of EACH strip off at a 45% angle (see image below)	 Cut ONE (1) 5 7/8" squares then cut this square diagonally TWO times.	 Cut FOUR (4) 2 1/8" x 7 3/4" strips then cut the ends of EACH strip off at a 45% angle (see image below)
					

Measure over the SIDE size from edge and draw a diagonal line from the bottom corner to your mark. Repeat on opposite side



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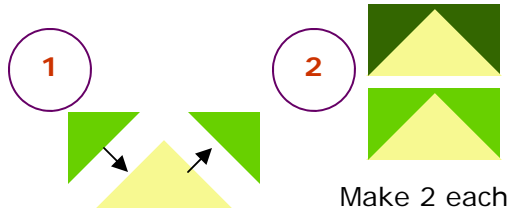
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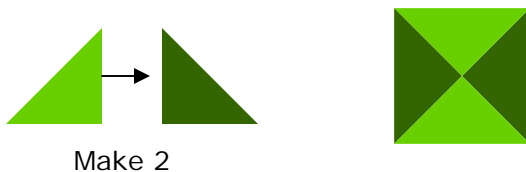


Sewing Instructions for Block 12

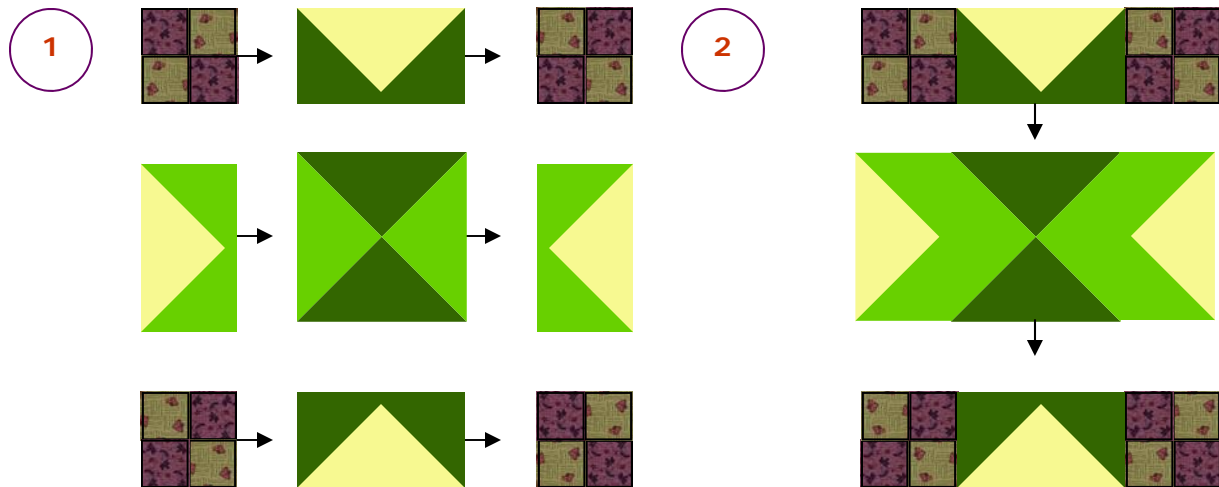
- 1) Sew all Fabric B 3 1/8" triangles to FOUR (4) Fabric E triangles. Press the first seam toward Fabric E and the second seam toward Fabric B (or A). Make TWO (2) with Fabric B and TWO (2) with Fabric A.



- 2) Sew ONE (1) of the larger Fabric B triangles to larger Fabric A triangle. Repeat with another Fabric A & Fabric B triangle and sew together to make your block center. Press toward the darkest fabric.



- 3) Begin piecing the remainder of your block, as shown:



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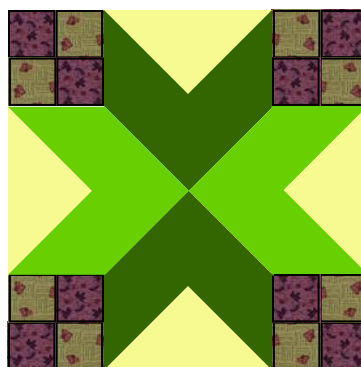
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Sewing Instructions for Block 12 (continued)



4) Finally, complete the rest of your block!

A -- sew 2 Fabric E strips to the left and right of your center half-square triangle square.

B -- sew your 4 four-square blocks to the ends of 2 of your Fabric E strips.

C -- sew the four-square strips made in B above to the top and bottom of your center half-square triangle rectangle.

D -- sew the 4 Fabric D strips to this center block.

E -- sew the Fabric F strips to the long edge of your Fabric C triangles.

F -- sew the center block to the corner triangles you made in E above!

Finished block will measure 14 5/8" square.
