## Cutting Instructions:

Color D - Cut 2 squares at $45 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square
Color D - Cut 2 squares at $41 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ square
Color E - Cut 2 squares at $45 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square
Color E - Cut 2 squares at $41 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ square
Color K - Cut 2 squares at $45 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square
Color K - Cut 8 squares at $41 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ square

## Additional Instructions:

Using a soft pencil or washable fabric marker and ruler, draw a single line from corner-to-corner on the wrong side of all Color E \& K $45 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

Piecing Instructions (all seams 1/4" seam allowance):


1) With right sides together, sew one Color D $45 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square to one Color E $45 / 8$ " square - sew on EACH SIDE (with your $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance) of the diagonal line that you drew. Once done, cut the square on the line that you drew and press toward Color D. Trim the corners (aka dog ears). You should end up with 2 half-square triangles.
2) You'll next need to sew one Color D $45 / 8$ " square to one Color K $45 / 8$ " square - and one color E $45 / 8$ " square to one color K $45 / 8$ " square. Sew on one side of the diagonal line that you drew. Once done, cut the squares on the line that you drew and press toward the dark color. Trim the corners (aka dog ears). (NOTE: You will not need the other side of the Colors D \& E triangles for this quilt block.)
3) Begin working with 2 blocks at a time, sewing them together in the pattern as shown in steps 2-5. Press seams toward RED line.


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Piecing Instructions (all seams 1/4" seam allowance). Press seams toward RED line:
