

"Georgia Sunshine" Installment 6 Instructions - Putting Your Quilt Together

Fabric	Cut
Maroon Flowers #1, Maroon Flowers #2, Blue Flowers #1, Blue Flowers #2	Cut ONE (1) 2 1/2" x 14 1/2" strips of EACH fabric
Maroon Flowers #1, Maroon Flowers #2, Blue Flowers #1, Blue Flowers #2	Cut ONE (1) 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" strips of EACH fabric
Pink (left & right Border 1)	Cut TWO (2) 2 1/2" x 46 1/2" strips
Pink (top & bottom Border 1)	Cut TWO (2) 2 1/2" x 51" strips
Blue Flowers #2 (left & right Border 2)	Cut TWO (2) 4" x 51" strips
Blue Flowers #2 (left & right Border 2)	Cut TWO (2) 4" x 57" strips
Blue Flowers #2 (binding)	Cut enough 2 1/2" x WOF strips to piece together to bind your quilt



Add the "Flowers" borders to the FOUR (4) pieced blocks you've already made, in the manner shown here.
