
"Bittersweet Churning" 2012 BOM Quilt

Since there are a number of colorways in this fabric line, I will use the basic color of the fabric and you use your own ingenuity to choose which fabrics you feel would be the best match for placement. The most important fabrics to keep track of are the focus fabrics and light fabrics in the half-square triangles at the corners of each of your blocks. They are not used elsewhere except in the sashing and borders.



BOM Quilts

Shoo Fly Block 6

Cutting for Block 6:	
Light Fabric	Cut TWO (2) 5 7/8" squares - draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, on the back of each of these squares
Pink Focus Fabric	Cut TWO (2) 5 7/8" squares
Orange Fabric	Cut ONE (1) 5 1/2" square
Lt. Purple Fabric	Cut FOUR (4)) 5 1/2" square


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


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Place the Green Focus square on the Light Fabric square and sew 1/4" on EACH side of the line you drew. Then, cut the half-square triangles apart ON the line you drew. You will end up with TWO (2) half-square triangles for each pair of squares you sew together. Press toward the darkest fabric.
