



"Pendleton Inspired" 2013 BOM Quilt

This is a raw-edge applique quilt, or an applique of your preference quilt. It is very geometrical and totally inspired by the Pendleton blankets from the Pendleton Woolen Mills in Pendleton, Oregon. www.BOMquilts.com!

All Seams 1/4"
Finished Quilt = 66" x 83"
Finished Block for Quilt = 15"
Unfinished Block for Quilt = 15 1/2"

Fabric: "Marblehead" Designed by Paintbrush Studio for Moda Purchase the Kit from <u>www.AbbiMays.com</u>

Purchase Aurifil Thread from Aurifil

This is an applique quilt. You can do raw-edge applique, fusible web applique, needle turn applique or any applique technique you prefer. The templates show the seam allowances so if you want to use raw-edge applique or fusible web applique, please cut on the template lines and not on the seam allowance lines.



Pendleton Inspired Block #5

Cutting for Block #5:	
Blue (background)	Use your blue background scraps that are already 15 1/2" long. You will need TWO (2) strips.
Yellow	Cut ONE (1) 4 1/2" x 15 1/2" strip
Pink	Cut FOUR (4) of the "D" triangles from template
Pink	Cut FOUR (4) of the "E" triangles from template
Purple	Cut FOUR (4) of the "D" triangles from template
	Cut FOUR (4) of the "E" triangles from template
Fusible Web	OPTIONAL for securing the appliquéd templates to the background fabric

Sew the Yellow strip to TWO (2) Blue strips and trim it up so it is 15 1/2" square. Center the template shapes on the background square and secure it with your applique preference.

Remember to leave at least a 1/4" seam allowance around the perimeter of the block.
