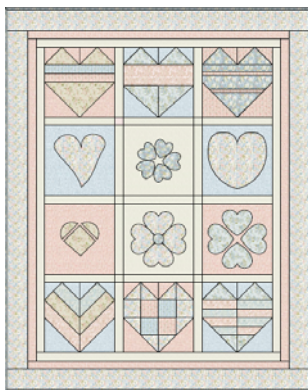

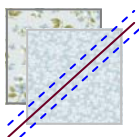

#### Fabric Cuts for “Shabby Love” Block #9

Fabric	Requirements Cuts
Floral Baby's Breath Blue	Cut ONE (1) 9 1/4" square. Then cut this square diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. You will end up with TWO (2) triangles.
Floral Tossed Light Blue	Cut THREE (3) 5" squares. On the back side of each square draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time.
Fresh Blossom Light Blue	Cut THREE (3) 5" squares.
Fresh Blossom Light Blue	Cut ONE (1) 9 1/4" square. Then cut this square diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. You will end up with TWO (2) triangles.
Arbor Paisley Light Pink	Cut FOUR (4) 2 1/2" x 9" strips
Arbor Paisley Light Blue	Cut FOUR (4) 2 1/2" x 9" strips

*Place the 5" FRESH BLOSSOM LIGHT BLUE square on the 5" FLORAL TOSSED LIGHT BLUE square (right sides together) and sew 1/4" on EACH SIDE of the line you drew. Then, cut the half-square triangles apart ON the line you drew. You will end up with TWO (2) half-square triangles per square. Press toward the darkest fabric. Clip the corners. Repeat for the remaining sets of squares of the same fabrics. Repeat the same process with the 9 1/4" squares.*

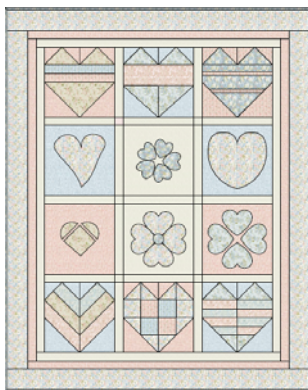
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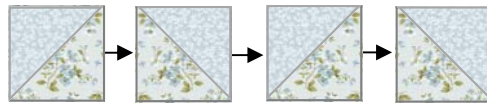

Sew all of the 2 1/2" x 9" strips together, alternating the pink and blue strips. Press all of the strips toward the BLUE fabrics. Then sew the strips together vertically, pressing the rows in the direction of each new strip.

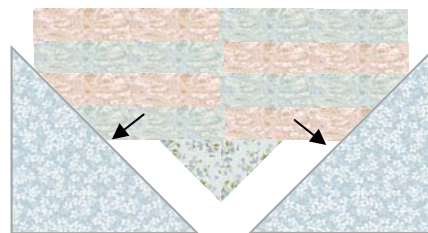

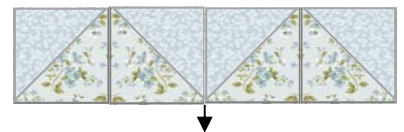
Once these two triangles are sewn together, sew them to the strips, pressing toward these triangles.

Sew the two 9 1/4" triangles to either side of the strip section. Fold the triangles over the strip section and trim the strip section evenly with the triangles.

This pattern has been tested, to the best of our ability. If your block does not come out the size shown, please try adjusting your needle position to the appropriate position (left or right)

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
