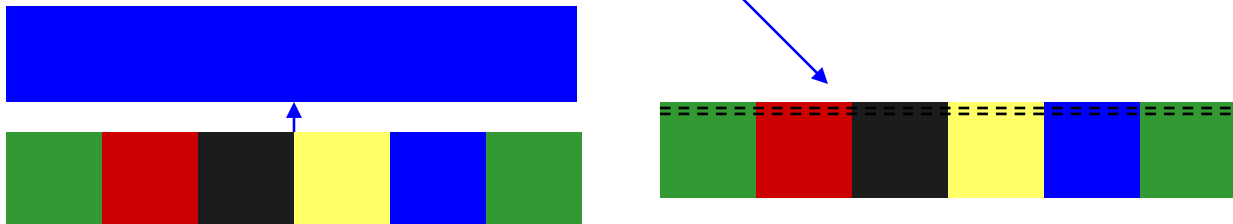
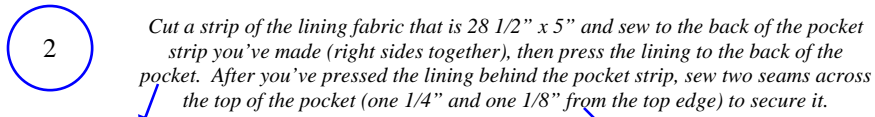

Completed Quilt Size: 28 1/2" x 33 1/2"
 Fabric requirements include the quilt top, borders and binding. Press in the direction of the arrows.



Sew the pocket together by sewing SIX (6) charm squares together.



This pattern has been tested, to the best of our ability. If your block does not come out the size shown, please try adjusting your needle position to the appropriate position (left or right) and see if you get the correct block size.

Carefully trim the center panel to the size of 19" wide x 24" height.

Now, begin sewing charm squares together to frame the center panel. You will need SIX (6) charm squares for the top and SEVEN (7) charm squares for the left and right sides.

Now, cut the bottom lining fabric 28 1/2" x 5", and sew to the bottom of the panel. Then, create your quilt sandwich and quilt your project before continuing.

Next, sew the pocket panel to the bottom of the quilt project, on top of the bottom lining and run a basting stitch around 1/8" around the outside of the pocket, to adhere it to the project.

Finally, sew seams every two charm squares, on the pocket, to secure it to the quilt project - giving you THREE (3) separate pockets.

To complete your quilt project, sew 2 1/2" x WOF strips together to create a binding for your project; and sew the binding to the project with 1/4" showing in the front. Then, add a rod-pocket on the back, if you desire, for hanging on your wall.

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
