
"Family Gathering Signature" Lap Quilt






Fabric requirements include all fabric for the project top, borders and binding. Finished Lap Quilt is 50" square. All seams are 1/4". Press in the direction of the arrows.

Finished Blocks: 7" square Unfinished Blocks: 7 1/2" square


Fabric	Amount
Lt. Green	1/4 yard
Dk. Green (includes border)	2 yards
Lt. Blue (includes binding)	1 yard
White	1/4 yard




Signature Leaf Block

Cutting for the Signature Leaf Block - these instructions are for ONE (1) block, remember to make THIRTY -SIX 36) of these blocks!

Fabric	Cuts
Lt. Blue	Cut ONE (1) 2 7/8" square
Lt. Blue	Cut TWO (2) 3 1/8" squares - on the wrong side of the fabric, draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner ONE (1) time on each square
White	Cut ONE (1) 2 7/8" square
Lt. Green	Cut ONE (1) 2 7/8" square
Dk. Green	Cut TWO (2) 2 7/8" square
Dk. Green	Cut TWO (2) 3 1/8" squares



Place the Lt. Blue square on the Dk. Green square and sew 1/4" on EACH side of the line you drew. Then, cut the half-square triangles apart ON the line you drew. You will end up with TWO (2) half-square triangles for each pair of squares you sew together. Press toward the darkest fabric.



Since you are sewing block to block with no sashing, you will want to sew one-half of the blocks pressed in the directions as the arrows show above and one-half of the blocks with the seams pressed in the opposite direction.

This pattern has been tested, to the best of our ability. If your block does not come out the size shown, please try adjusting your needle position to the appropriate position (left or right) and see if you get the correct block size.



Since you are sewing block to block with no sashing, you will want to sew one-half of the blocks pressed in the directions as the arrows show and one-half of the blocks with the seams pressed in the opposite direction.

Cutting borders and binding for finishing your quilt top		
Fabric	Amounts	
Dk. Green	TWO (2) 4" x 42 1/2" strips for left and right border	
Dk. Green	TWO (2) 4" x 49 1/2" strips for top and bottom border	
Lt. Blue	Cut enough 2 1/2" x WOF strips to piece together to bind your completed quilt	

If you want this to be a true signature quilt, you have a few options for writing in the white center portion of your blocks. You can use permanent fabric markers. You can use pencil to write a name (or whatever you want) and then hand-embroider over the pencil. Or you could use an embroidery machine to sew what you want in the signature squares. We suggest you put each block together before writing in the white block, that way you do not have to worry about someone writing too close to the edge and into your seam allowance. It's also best to have your signatures placed on the quilt before you get it quilted.


