




Fabric requirements include all fabric for the project top and binding.

## Finished Quilt is 56" square All seams are 1/4" Press to the darkest fabric.

Center Medallion is 25" finished, 25 1/2" unfinished. Border #1 is 5" finished, 5 1/2" unfinished. Border #2 is 10" finished, 10 1/2" unfinished.

Fabric Requirements	Amount
Green	1 yard (includes border #1)
Red	1 1/2 yards (includes border #2)
Lt. Green	1 3/4 yards (includes borders #1 & #2)
White	2 yards (includes borders #1 & #2)
Fusible Web (optional)	2 yards



Cutting for the Quilt—Block 1: Remember that this Block #1 is a 25" fin- ished square.	
Fabric	Cuts
Green	Cut ONE (1) "A" from attached template.
Red	Cut FOUR (4) "C" from attached template
White	Cut FOUR (4) "D" from attached template
Lt. Green	Cut ONE (1) 25 1/2" square

Center Medallion Block #1

I prefer to use raw-edge applique so I just use pins to secure my templates to the background fabric. The optional fusible web is for folks who prefer to applique that way. The templates show a border around each template, that is for those of you who like to applique by hand. You do NOT need to use the seam allowance if you are not hand-appliqueing your template pieces.



Block #2 Border #1 Cutting for the Quilt—Block 2 for Border #1: Remember that this Border block is a 5" finished square. These instructions are for ONE (1) block, you need to make FOUR (4) of these blocks for this quilt.

	Fabric	Cuts
	Green	Cut ONE (1) "E" from attached template.
	Red	Cut FOUR (4) "C" from attached template
	White	Cut FOUR (4) "D" from attached template
	Lt. Green	Cut ONE (1) 5 1/2" square



Block #3 Border #2 Cutting for the Quilt—Block 3 for Border #2: Remember that this Border block is a 10" finished square. These instructions are for ONE (1) block, you need to make FOUR (4) of these blocks for this quilt.

	Fabric	Cuts
	Green	Cut ONE (1) "E" from attached template.
	Red	Cut FOUR (4) "C" from attached template
¢3	White	Cut FOUR (4) "D" from attached template
#2	Lt. Green	Cut ONE (1) 10 1/2" square

## Once you have all of your "candy" templates completed, it's time to cut the remaining fabrics for the "Hard Candy Christmas" quilt top!

Cutting for the Quilt—the remaining fabric cuts needed for the "Hard Candy Christmas" quilt.		
Fabric	Cuts	
Green	Cut FOUR (4) 5 1/2" x 25 1/2" strips (border #1)	
Red	Cut SIXTEEN (16) 5 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips (border #2)	
White	Cut TWELVE (12) 5 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips (border #2)	
Green	Cut and piece enough 2 1/2" x WOF strips to bind your quilt	


