colors are not applicable to your religious affiliation, feel free to substitute with the colors of your choice.


Fabric requirements include all fabric for the project top and binding.

Finished Quilt is 73 " square All seams are 1/4" Press in the direction of the arrows.

Finished Blocks: 8" square Unfinished Blocks: 8 1/2" square

| Fabric | Amount |
| :--- | :--- |
| Green | $21 / 4$ yards (includes border) |
| Tan | 1 yard (includes border squares and binding) |
| Blue | 3 yards |

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Block \#1
Tree Top


Make TWO (2)

Place the Blue 5" square on the Green 5" fabric square and sew 1/4" on EACH side of the line you drew. Then, cut the half-square triangles apart ON the line you drew. Finally, take your finished half-square triangles and trim them so they are $41 / 2$ "x 8 1/2". You will end up with TWO (2) half-square triangles for each pair of squares you sew together. Press toward the darkest fabric.


Make FOUR (4)


Block \#2
Tree Bottom

Cutting for the Quilt-Block 2: These instructions are for ONE (1) block. You need to make FOUR (4) of these blocks for the quilt.

| Fabric | Cuts |
| :--- | :--- |
| Tan | Cut ONE (1) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips |
| Blue | Cut ONE (1) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips |



Make FOUR (4)



Cutting for the Quilt-Block 3: These instructions are for ONE (1) block. You need to make TWELVE (12) of these blocks for the quilt.

| Fabric | Cuts |
| :--- | :--- |
| Green | Cut ONE (1) 9" square. |
| Blue | Cut ONE (1) 9" square. Then draw a diagonal line, cor- <br> ner-to-corner, ONE (1) time on the back of the square. |

Block \#3
Tree Top


Make SIX (6) because each square makes TWO (2) half-square triangles.

Place the Blue 10" square on the Green 10" fabric square and sew 1/4" on $E A C H$ side of the line you drew. Then, cut the half-square triangles apart ON the line you drew. Finally, take your finished half-square triangles and trim them so they are 8 1/2" square. You will end up with TWO (2) half-square triangles for each pair of squares you sew together. Press half of the halfsquare triangles toward the Blue fabric and half of the half-square triangles toward the Green fabric.

Final Fabric Cuts for the Quilt:

| Fabric | Cuts |
| :--- | :--- |
| Green | Cut TEN (10) $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares |
| Blue | Cut THIRTY-FOUR (34) $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares |
| Tan (for border) | Cut EIGHT (8) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares |
| Green (for border) | Cut EIGHT (8) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 301 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips |
| Tan (binding) | Cut and piece together enough $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips to create the binding for <br> your quilt |
