#### Introduction Page

This image shows one **Block Set**.

To make a table topper, make one Block Set (24" square before a Border and Binding)

To make a bed runner, depending on the size of the bed, make three or more Block Sets.

To make a lap quilt make four Block Sets.

To make a larger quilt, make the number of block sets that will create the size of quilt you desire.

#### Fabric Requirements for ONE (1) Block Set



Tossed Greenery Lt. Teal 1/4 yard



Wreaths Multi 1/4 yard



Snowflake White on White ONE (1) Fat Quarter



Diagonal Stripe Taupe/ Red - 1/4 yard






| Cutting for the "Christmas Treetop Gathering" Block Set. |   |
|--|---|
| Fabric   | Cuts  |
| Tossed Greenery Lt. Teal                                 | Cut ONE (1) 8 1/2" square   |
| Tossed Greenery Lt. Teal                                 | Cut TWO (2) 8 7/8" squares. Then cut the squares diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. You will end up with TWO (2) triangles per square. |
| Wreaths Multi  | Cut FOUR (4) 4 1/2" squares   |
| Diagonal Stripe Taupe/Red                                | Cut FOUR (4) 4 7/8" squares   |
| Snowflake White on White                                 | Cut FOUR (4) 4 7/8" squares. On the back side of each square draw a diagonal line, corner-to -corner, ONE (1) time.                             |
| Snowflake White on White                                 | Cut FOUR (4) 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips   |
| Snowflake White on White                                 | Cut ONE (1) 9 1/4" square. Then cut the square diagonally, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time.<br>You will end up with FOUR (4) triangles.          |

#### Piecing Instructions for ONE (1) Block Set



Place the SNOWFLAKE WHITE ON WHITE 4 7/8" fabric square on the DIAGONAL STRIPE TAUPE/RED 4 7/8" fabric square and sew 1/4" on <u>EACH</u> side of the line you drew. Then, cut the half-square triangles apart ON the line you drew. You will end up with TWO (2) half-square triangles for each pair of squares you sew together. Press toward the darkest fabric.








