
FQS Spencer's Museum Memories

A Museum-Quality Quilt with an Artistic Interpretation of Traditional Pieced Blocks 2006 Row of the Month Quilt from BOMQuilts.com & FatQuarterShop.com

July 21, 2006 - Row 4



No cutting if you purchased the Spencer Museum Memories Charm Packs from FatQuarterShop.com! If you didn't, the squares are 5" each. And, we are going to piece 1 row (see circled image)!

Sort your charm packs by color. You will need 32 charm squares for this row.


Mark the back of the lighter 2 fabrics with TWO di-

agonal lines, from corner to corner, with a pencil or washable fabric marker.

Sew your blocks with a 1/4" seam allowance. These blocks are made up of quarter-square triangles. You will sew two charm squares together (color of choice) on BOTH sides of ONE of the lines you drew. Once done, cut the squares on the OPPOSITE line you drew. Press seams to the darkest fabric.



Make quarter-square triangles out of all of your blocks, and then piece them as shown, pressing in opposite directions with your rows so as to reduce seam bulk.
