
Cutting Your Fabrics

Fabric	Cut (WOF = width of fabric)
Fabric A - Red (small textured dots)	Cut one 9" square piece for the rooster - remaining fabric will be used in Instruction #2
Fabric B - Chicken Wire	Cut one (1) 12 ½" square
Fabric C - Black with Stars	1) Cut two (2) 9" squares 2) Cut squares diagonally, from corner to corner, once
Fabric D - turquoise border fabric	Cut three (3) 1 ¼" WOF strips
Fusible Web	9" square cut


Piecing Your Fabrics

All Seam Allowances 1/4" unless otherwise noted.

- 1) Following the manufacturer's instructions for your fusible web, trace and cut out the rooster using the enclosed pattern and Fabric A.
- 2) Machine or hand appliqué the Fabric A rooster to Fabric B.
- 3) Sew the long side of your four Fabric C triangles to the sides of the rooster appliqué block as shown. Press toward **red line** and clip your corners when done:
- 4) With Fabric D strips, sew the border to your rooster center as shown (top & bottom first, then left & right sides). Press toward Fabric D when done:



Now you're ready for Instruction #2!





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Enlarge rooster 230% or large enough to fill the center fabric square on your quilt top.

Needle and String Not Included in Kit. These should be embellishments you add to your finished rooster, not part of the appliqué.
