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Cutting Your Fabrics

Fabric	Cut (WOF = width of fabric)
Fabric A - Red (small textured dots)	Cut four (4) 2" x WOF strips
Fabric C - Black (med. circle fabric)	Cut four (4) 2" x WOF strips
Fabric D - turquoise border fabric	Cut four (4) 1 ¼" WOF strips

Piecing Your Fabrics

All Seam Allowances 1/4" unless otherwise noted.


- 1) Sew your strips of Fabric A & Fabric C together, pressing toward the darkest fabric.



- 2) Cut 2 ½" double blocks out of your fabric strips. You need 16 each for the top and bottom and 12 each for the left and right sides.



- 3) Piece your double blocks into four-patch blocks ... continue until you have enough to add to your quilt top. Press in direction of choice.



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
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
Piecing Your Fabrics (continued)

All Seam Allowances 1/4" unless otherwise noted.

4) Now, sew your finished borders to your center rooster (left and right first, then top and bottom) and add your Fabric D borders (top and bottom first, then left and right) as in Instruction #1:
